Smith led the Cavaliers to a 2-0 week in the program's final two games with 47 points, eight rebounds, four assists and three steals. He shot 48.5 percent from the field, 50 percent from three-point range and a perfect 9 of 9 from the free-throw line. Smith led the way with 21 points in Thursday's 78-73 win over Alaska, connecting on 8 of 16 from

the field, to go with five rebounds and two assists. Smith then led all scorers with 26 points on 8 of 17 from the field, 4 of 6 from three-point range and 6 of 6 from the free-throw line in the 72-69 win over Alaska Anchorage.

Around The GNAC

CONCORDIA CLOSSES SHOP AS GNAC TEAM OF THE WEEK: The Concordia men's basketball team hosted the program's final homestand last week, sweeping the Alaska schools at a lively LCEF Court to earn selection as the GNAC Team of the Week.

Both games went down to the wire as the Cavaliers edged out Alaska on Thursday, 78-73, before beating Alaska Anchorage on Saturday, 72-69. Senior guard **Xavier Smith** put the game against the Nanooks on ice, nailing two free throws to put the Cavs up by five with two seconds remaining. Smith also made a pair of free throws with four seconds left against the Seawolves to put the Cavs up by three, forcing the Seawolves to take one final three-point attempt, which was missed.

"We were able to go off emotions and that carried us through the first half," head coach **Rodrick Rhodes** said about Saturday's win over the Seawolves. "We didn't want to lose and I think you saw that in our kids. They never quit. They came to practice every day, practiced hard and deserve all the credit."

Smith was named the GNAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week after he led the Cavs with 47 points on 48.5 percent from the field, 50 percent from three-point range and 100 percent from the free-throw line. Smith opened the week with 21 points on 8 of 16 from the field to go with five rebounds, two assists and a steal against the Nanooks. He finished the week with a game-high 26 points on 8 of 17 from the field, 4 of 6 from beyond the arc and 6 of 6 from the free-throw line while adding three rebounds, two assists and two steals against the Seawolves.

GNAC Championships Preview

SEATTLE, Wash. – There is no place like Brougham.

A year after capturing the conference title two hours away in Bellingham, Seattle Pacific has the chance to repeat after earning the top seed in the 2020 GNAC Men's Basketball Championships. The Falcons will host this year's tournament at Royal Brougham Pavilion beginning on Thursday.

After opening the season with a 0-4 record, the Falcons were nearly unstoppable the rest of the way by winning 22 of their next 24 games. The run included a near-record 14-game win streak that ran from November 16 to January 25. Seattle Pacific clinched the regular-season championship with an 18-2 conference mark.

The Falcons present a balanced attack that keeps opponents on their toes. Averaging 79.3 points per game, SPU leads the GNAC and is 16th in Division II with a .497 field goal percentage and is sixth nationally with a .802 free-throw percentage. Conversely, the Falcons' 69.8 points allowed per game and .328 opponent three-point percentage lead the league.

Sophomore **Divant'e Moffitt** has paced the Falcons offensively, ranking fourth in the GNAC in scoring at 16.8 points per game while also ranking sixth with 3.46 assists per contest. Junior guard **Harry Cavell** is a threat on both ends of the floor, averaging 13.6 points per game while ranking eighth in the GNAC with 6.7 rebounds per contest. Forward **Shaw Anderson** has emerged as one of the most dynamic freshmen in the league, averaging 12.8 points and 4.6 rebounds per game while ranking seventh in the GNAC with a .554 field goal percentage.

After missing the GNAC Championships in Bellingham last year, Western Washington returns to the tournament as the No. 2 seed. The Vikings capitalized on a strong January to solidify its spot, going 7-2 on the month and, at one point, amassing an eight-game win streak.

One of two teams in the tournament field to have beaten Seattle Pacific this season, the Vikings are second in the GNAC with both 79.6 points and 37.4 rebounds per game. The defense is averaging 5.25 blocked shots per game, which rank third in Division II.

Senior forward **Trevor Jasinsky**, the GNAC Preseason Player of the Year, leads the Vikings with averages of 14.4 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. Senior guard **Jalen Green** is averaging 13 points and 5.9 rebounds per game while his 1.52 blocks per game are third in the GNAC. Senior forward **Logan Schilder** is just ahead of Green and is 17th in Division II with 2.08 blocks per game. Freshman guard **D'Angelo Minnis** has been an immediate contributor, averaging 12.2 points per game.

Picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll after the loss of its head coach and several key contributors, Western Oregon returns as the No. 3 seed. First-year head coach **Wes Pifer** succeeding in keeping the Wolves in place as one of the top offensive teams in Division II. The Wolves enter the GNAC Championships having made the final in each of the last four years.

Leading the GNAC and ranked 21st in Division II with an average of 86.6 points per game, WOU leads Division II with a .824 free-throw percentage. The Wolves are second in the league and 23rd nationally with a .492 field goal percentage and also rank 12th in Division II with a .407 three-point percentage. One of the best teams in the nation in taking care of the ball, WOU is 25th nationally in fewest turnovers with 316.



Senior guard **Dalven Brushier** is third in the GNAC in scoring at 18 points per game, ranks second with a .862 free-throw percentage and is fourth with 2.69 three-pointers made per game. Senior guard **Jaylyn Richardson** is averaging 13.2 points per game and is sixth in the GNAC with a .458 three-point percentage. Sophomore guard **John Morrill-Keeler** is among the most accurate shooters in the league, ranking third with a .589 field goal percentage.

Northwest Nazarene bounced back from losing the conference's top two scorers to claim the No. 4 seed in the tournament. With the loss in scoring power, the Nighthawks have made defense their hallmark. They lead the conference with 37.9 rebounds per game and are third with 73.6 points allowed per game. The team's league-leading .420 opponent field goal percentage ranks 30th in Division II.

Junior guard **Ezekiel Alley** has played the sixth-man role like no one else. In 24 games off the bench, Alley ranks fifth in the GNAC with 16.5 points per game and is third with 1.54 steals per contest. Senior forward **Olamilekan "Spider" Adetunji** leads the conference with 8.4 rebounds per game while also ranking sixth with a .561 field-goal percentage. Senior guard **Jayden Bezzant** provides additional scoring muscle at 14.3 points per game.

Entering as the No. 5 seed, Alaska Anchorage is in the GNAC Championships for the first time since 2018. After a strong start in the non-conference season where they won eight of their first 10 games, the Seawolves surged into the postseason by winning four of their final six contests. Averaging 79.1 points per game, Alaska Anchorage leads the GNAC and is 11th in Division II with a .411 three-point percentage.

One of two players to rank in the GNAC's top-10 in both scoring and rebounding, junior forward **Oggie Pantovic** is 10th in the conference at 15.1 points per game and third with 7.8 rebounds per contest. Senior guard **Niko Bevens** is averaging 13.1 points per game and ranks third in Division II with 106 made three-pointers. His .455 three-point percentage is 20th nationally. Sophomore guard **Tobin Karlberg** adds 12.9 points per game while his .520 three-point percentage is second in Division II.

Alaska returns to the GNAC Championships for the first time 2016 while head coach **Greg Sparling** is in for his eighth time after leading Central Washington to seven tournament berths. The Nanooks played their way into the tournament thanks to a strong first half that saw UAF go 5-3 over the opening stretch of conference play. Alaska is averaging 76.1 points per game and is third in the GNAC with 8.04 steals per game.

The Nanooks are led by dynamic junior guard **Shadeed Shabazz**, who enters the tournament ranked sixth in the GNAC in scoring at 26 points per game. Shabazz has scored 20 or more points in 20 of his 28 games and 30 or more points 11 times. He has two 43-point performances on the year, which ties for sixth-best in GNAC history. He is also ranked No. 1 in Division II with 3.93 steals per game. Senior guard **Spencer Sweet** averages 13.2 points per game.

Action begins on Thursday at noon with No. 6 Alaska facing No. 3 Western Oregon. The winner of that game advances to play No. 2 Western Washington on Friday at noon. No. 5 Alaska Anchorage will face No. 4 Northwest Nazarene on Thursday at 2:15 p.m., with the winner facing top-seeded Seattle Pacific on Friday at 2:15 p.m. The championship final will be played on Saturday at 5 p.m.

Around The GNAC

ALASKA



- Alaska qualified for its first GNAC Championships since 2016 despite two road losses in the final regular season weekend, falling at Concordia on Thursday, 78-73, and at Western Oregon on Saturday, 95-89.

- Junior guard **Shadeed Shabazz** finished with 62 points, 10 rebounds, seven assists and eight steals on the road trip. At

Concordia, Shabazz finished with 27 points and six rebounds. He then notched his 11th 30-plus point night of the season at Western Oregon, finishing with 35 points to go with four rebounds, three assists and seven steals. Shabazz leads the GNAC and is sixth in Division II with 26 points per game. He also leads Division II with 3.89 steals per game and 110 total steals.

- Freshman forward **Mawich Kachjaani** added 26 points and 20 rebounds in the two games. He opened the road trip with 10 points and six rebounds at Concordia before notching a double-double of 16 points and 14 rebounds at Western Oregon on 5 of 7 from the field. For the week, Kachjaani made 72.7 percent from the field and 10 of 10 from the free-throw line. Kachjaani enters the week averaging 5.5 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.

- Alaska enters the week averaging 76.1 points and 29.9 rebounds per game. The Nanooks are third in the GNAC with 8.04 steals per game.

- The No. 6 seed in this week's GNAC Championships, the Nanooks last appeared in the tournament in 2016. Earning the No. 2 seed that year, Alaska advanced to the final and lost to Western Oregon 76-71. This will be head coach **Greg Sparling's** eighth GNAC Championships appearance and his first with the Nanooks. Thursday's quarterfinals matchup with Western Oregon will be a rematch of Saturday's regular-season finale.

ALASKA ANCHORAGE



- Alaska Anchorage took two losses to close the regular season, falling 85-84 at Western Oregon on Thursday and 72-69 at Concordia on Saturday. Despite the losses, the Seawolves enter the GNAC Championships having won four of their last six games.

- Junior forward **Oggie Pantovic** led the Seawolves with 36 points and 19 rebounds in the two games, shooting 56 percent from the field and a near-perfect 8 of 9 from the free-throw line. Pantovic just missed a double-double at Western Oregon with 24 points and nine rebounds, shooting 10 of 14 from the field. Pantovic got the double-double at Concordia, connecting for 12 points and 10 rebounds. Pantovic is 10th in the GNAC with 15.1 points per game and third with 7.8 rebounds per game.

- Senior guard **Tyrus Hosley** contributed 34 points, 11 rebounds and six assists on the road trip. Hosley opened with 15 points and four assists at Western Oregon, shooting 6 of 10 from the field. He just missed a double-double at Concordia with 19 points and eight rebounds. Hosley is averaging 11.8 points per game and is ninth in the GNAC with 3.30 assists per game.

- Alaska Anchorage is fourth in the GNAC with 79.1 points per game and is averaging 32.9 rebounds per game. The Seawolves are seventh in Division II with a 1.56 assist/turnover ratio, ninth with 923 three-point attempts, and 13th with 18 assists per game. Individually, senior guard **Niko Bevens** is fifth in Division II with 107 three-pointers made and 20th with a .451 three-point percentage. Additionally, sophomore **Tobin Karlberg** is second in Division II with a .520 three-point percentage.

- Alaska Anchorage is in the GNAC Championships for the first time since 2018 and the ninth time in tournament history. The Seawolves were also the No. 5 seed that season and fell to Seattle Pacific in the quarterfinals, 64-51.

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene lost both games on the road to end the regular season, taking a 72-70 loss at Seattle Pacific on Thursday and a 70-66 loss at Saint Martin's on Saturday.

- Junior guard **Ezekiel Alley** continued his sixth-man surge, leading the Nighthawks with 37 points in the two games.

Alley opened with 22 points at Seattle Pacific in 30 minutes off the bench. He then contributed 15 points at Saint Martin's. Playing in 24 of NNU's 25 games off of the bench, Alley leads the team and is fifth in the GNAC with 16.5 points per game and is third in the GNAC with 1.54 steals per game.

- Senior forward **Adalberto Diaz** added 20 points and 13 rebounds on the road trip. He scored 10 points in both games, notching a double-double with 10 rebounds at Seattle Pacific while finishing with three rebounds at Saint Martin's. Diaz is averaging 12.7 points per game.

- Senior guard **Jayden Bezzant** finished with 18 points and 10 assists over the two games, scoring 11 at Seattle Pacific and contributing six assists at Saint Martin's. Bezzant is averaging 14.3 points per game and is fourth in the GNAC with four assists per game.

- Northwest Nazarene is averaging 76.3 points per game and leads the GNAC with 37.9 rebounds per game. The Nighthawks lead the GNAC and rank 30th in Division II in field goal defense (.430). They also rank third in the GNAC with a .474 field goal percentage.

- Northwest Nazarene's appearance in the 2019 GNAC Championships was the team's first since 2015. The 2020 appearance is just the third all-time for the Nighthawks. The No. 3 seed in 2019, NNU advanced to the semifinals before taking an 89-81 loss to Seattle Pacific.

SEATTLE PACIFIC



- Seattle Pacific closed out the regular season with two home wins, taking a 72-70 victory from Northwest Nazarene on Thursday and a 63-56 win from Central Washington on Saturday.

- Sophomore guard **Divant'e Moffitt** led the way for the Falcons with 38 points and 10 assists in the two games.

Moffitt opened with 20 points, six assists and four rebounds against Northwest Nazarene, connecting on 7 of 14 from the field and 6 of 7 from the free-throw line. He then added an 18-point performance against Central Washington to go with four more rebounds and four assists. Moffitt is fourth in the GNAC with 16.8 points per game and sixth with 3.46 assists per contest.

- Junior guard **Harry Cavell** finished with 34 points and nine rebounds, connecting on 62.5 percent from the field. Cavell scored 17 points in both games, making 7 of 9 from the field and 2 of 3 from three-point range against Northwest Nazarene while adding five rebounds and three assists against Central Washington. Cavell averages 13.8 points per game and ranks eighth in the GNAC with 6.7 rebounds per game.

- Seattle Pacific is third in the GNAC with 80.2 points per game and is averaging 32.9 rebounds per game. The Falcons lead the GNAC and rank 16th in Division II with a .497 field goal percentage while also ranking sixth in Division II with a .802 free-throw percentage.

- Seattle Pacific enters the GNAC Championships ranked No. 22 in the D2SIDA Media Poll and is tied for 25th in the NABC Poll. Seattle Pacific was No. 5 in the latest NCAA Division II West Region Rankings, released last Wednesday.

- Last year's winner of the GNAC Championships, Seattle Pacific is in the tournament for the ninth time and the second time as the No. 1 seed (the last time was 2014). In last year's tournament, the Falcons beat Northwest Nazarene in the semifinals, 89-81, before beating No. 4 Western Oregon in the final by a score of 78-66.

Around The GNAC

WESTERN OREGON



- Western Oregon finished the regular season with two home wins, taking an 85-84 victory from Alaska Anchorage on Thursday and a 95-89 win from Alaska on Saturday. The Wolves enter the GNAC Championships having won six of their last seven games.
- Senior guard **Jaylyn Richardson** led the Wolves in the two victories with 43 points, connecting on 64 percent from the field and 53.8 percent from three-point range. Richardson opened the week with 16 points against Alaska Anchorage, making 7 of 12 from the field. He then scored 27 points against Alaska on 9 of 13 from the field and 5 of 8 from three-point range. Richardson is averaging 13.2 points per game.
- Senior guard **Dalven Brushier** scored 41 points in the two games on 57.1 percent shooting from the field. Brushier scored 19 points against Alaska Anchorage, connecting on 7 of 11 from the field. He then scored 22 points against Alaska on 9 of 17 from the field to go with four rebounds. Brushier is third in the GNAC with 18 points per game and ranks fourth with 2.69 three-pointers made per game.
- Western Oregon leads the GNAC and is 21st in Division II with 86.6 points per game. The Wolves lead the GNAC and Division II with a .824 free-throw percentage (260-318). They also rank second in the GNAC and rank 12th in Division II with a .407 three-point percentage.
- The Wolves were ranked No. 10 in the latest NCAA West Region Rankings of the season released last Wednesday.
- Western Oregon is in the GNAC Championships for the seventh consecutive year and the ninth time in program history. The Wolves have made the final game each of the last four years and lost in last year's championship to Seattle Pacific, 78-66.

WESTERN WASHINGTON



- Western Washington split in its final weekend of the regular season, collecting a 69-60 win from Simon Fraser on Tuesday before taking an 86-79 road loss at Montana State Billings on Thursday. The Vikings enter the GNAC Championships having won four of their last five games.
- Freshman guard **D'Angelo Minnis** led the Vikings with 26 points in the two games to go with seven rebounds and five assists. Minnis did his most damage against Simon Fraser, scoring 20 points on 8 of 11 from the field. He then finished with six points, four rebounds and three assists at Montana State Billings. Minnis is averaging 12.2 points per game and is 10th in the GNAC with 3.11 assists per game.
- Senior guard/forward **Siaan Rojas** finished with 26 points and 11 rebounds in the split week. Rojas just missed a double-double with totals of 10 points and eight rebounds against Simon Fraser. He then added 16 points at Montana State Billings, including 3 of 6 from three-point range. Rojas is averaging 10.2 points per game.
- Senior forward **Trevor Jasinsky** finished with 23 points last week, led by his 13 points on 6 of 10 from the field at Montana State Billings. Jasinsky is the Vikings' leading scorer with 14.4 points per game.
- The Vikings rank second in the GNAC with 79.6 points per game and second with 37.4 rebounds per game. Western also leads the GNAC and is third in Division II with 5.3 blocked shots per game.
