Chavez helped propel the Saints to their first GNAC regular-season championship with 56 points, 12 rebounds and seven assists in the two games, shooting 51.7 percent from the field and 18 of 19 from the free throw line. Chavez scored 23 points and grabbed seven rebounds in Thursday's 97-87 win at Northwest Nazarene to go with 12 of 13 from

the free throw line and four assists. Chavez closed out the regular season with a 33-point performance in a 105-96, double-overtime win at Central Washington. He connected on 11 of 18 from the field, 5 of 11 from three-point range and 6 of 6 from the free throw line.

GNAC CHAMPIONSHIPS FINAL GAINS NATIONAL EXPOSURE: For the third time in four years, the GNAC Basketball Championships will play out in front of a national audience.

Saturday's men's and women's championship games have been selected to be webcast on ESPN3 as part of the NCAA Division II Basketball Showcase. The webcast was announced by the NCAA on Monday afternoon.

"We are excited to have another opportunity to showcase the best basketball in the GNAC," GNAC commissioner **Dave Haglund** said. "To have our GNAC Championships selected for the third time in four years is a testament to the quality of basketball that our teams play. We look forward to sharing it with the national audience."

Darren Goldwater and **Leah Secondo** will provide the descriptions of the games. This is Goldwater's second GNAC Championships having called the 2018 GNAC Championships in Anchorage on ESPN3. Secondo is a veteran basketball broadcaster who has worked calling men's and women's basketball broadcasts since the mid-1990s.

With the games picked up for the Division II Basketball Showcase, the Saturday finals will be available exclusively on ESPN3 and WatchESPN.com. Access to the games is free of charge to fans with subscriptions to participating high-speed internet providers. ESPN3 is also available at no cost to U.S. college students and U.S.-based military personnel on computers connected on on-campus educational networks.

The quarterfinal and semifinal rounds of the GNAC Basketball Championships will be streamed at GNAC.tv.

2018-19 GNAC Championships Preview

BELLINGHAM, Wash. – Saint Martin's is the team to beat, but a combination of tournament newcomers and postseason veterans will make for an exciting GNAC Men's Basketball Championships, which commences on Thursday at Western Washington University's Carver Gym.

The Saints, in the tournament for the fourth-straight year, enters having won the program's first GNAC regular-season championship. Experienced in the postseason. Saint Martin's advanced to last year's GNAC Championships final and earned the school's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Tournament.

Seattle Pacific, playing in its eighth tournament in nine years, and defending tournament champion Western Oregon come in as the tournament veterans. Montana State Billings is in the field for the fifth time, but its first since 2017, while surging Northwest Nazarene is making just its second GNAC Championships appearance. The bracket is rounded out by Simon Fraser, which makes its first postseason appearance since joining the GNAC in 2010.

The building process that Saint Martin's has seen over the last three years is building to a crescendo. The Saints captured their first GNAC regular-season championship with a 17-4 record and 24-4 overall mark. Saint Martin's has excelled with a team-oriented offensive approach with senior guards **Luke Chavez** and **EJ Boyce** both averaging 13.2 points per game and senior transfer **Chandler Redix** averaging 12 points per game.

The bulk of the Saints' success, however, has centered around defense. The team ranks second in the GNAC in scoring defense (68.1 points allowed per game), first in three-point defense (.319) and third in field goal defense (.434), which has allowed Saint Martin's to outscore opponents by an average of 10.5 points per game.

Seattle Pacific, the tournament's No. 2 seed, enters the championship riding a 10-game win streak. During that stretch, the Falcons have outscored opponents by an average of 14 points per game and outrebounded foes by 13 per game. Overall, the Falcons lead the GNAC in rebounding (38.4 per game) and rebounding defense (29.8 per game) and rank second in field goal percentage (.486).

The Falcons spread the offensive wealth well with four players averaging over 10 points per game. Junior guard **Gavin Long** is averaging 13.4 points per game. Senior guard **Nikhil Lizotte** is averaging 12.9 points per game while ranking fourth in the GNAC with a .878 free throw percentage. Senior forward **Coleman Wooten** is scoring 12.2 points per game while ranking second in the GNAC with 7.8 rebounds per contest.

The No. 3 seed in the tournament, Northwest Nazarene is making its first GNAC Championships appearance since the inaugural edition in 2011. The Nighthawks are the top offensive team in the conference, averaging 85 points per game while making 50.2 percent of their shots from the field. The team is also defensively stout, leading the conference in field goal defense (.418) and ranking second in both rebounding (37.7 per game) and blocked shots (4.1 per game).



Northwest Nazarene boasts the top two scorers in the conference. Junior **Adonis Arms** is averaging 20.9 points per game, making 56 percent of his shots from the field, while senior **Obi Megwa** is averaging 19.2 points per game. Junior **Jayden Bezzant** has been a key spark plug off the bench, averaging 12.8 points per game while making 54.5 percent from the field and 40 percent from three-point range.

The defending tournament champions, No. 4 seed Western Oregon has rebounded well after the loss of a number of key contributors off the 2017-18 squad. The Wolves secured their playoff spot by winning three of their final four games, including a critical home victory over Northwest Nazarene. Another defensive-minded program, Western Oregon leads the league in scoring

defense (65.7 points allowed per game), steals (8 per game) and turnover margin (+5.58) while also topping the GNAC in scoring margin (+12.1).

The Wolves have also spread out the offense with four starters averaging over 10 points per game. Junior forward **Riley Hawken** averages 12.3 points and 6.5 rebounds per game and also leads the GNAC with two steals per game. Junior guard **Dalven Brushier** is averaging 11.3 points per contest while senior forward **Kaleb Warner** averages 11 points per game.

Montana State Billings, the No. 5 seed, returns to the GNAC Championships for the first time since 2017 under first-year head coach **Mick Durham**. The Yellowjackets secured their berth with a sweep of the Alaska road trip in the final weekend of the season, including a 67-56 win at Alaska Anchorage that saw MSUB outscore their hosts 43-27 in the second half. A solid outside-shooting program, MSUB is fourth in the GNAC in scoring at 79.5 points per game and ranks third with a .377 three-point percentage.

The Yellowjackets are led by dynamic freshman forward **Brendan Howard**, who ranks fifth in the GNAC with 15.6 points per game in 28 games while playing primarily in a sixth-man role. Junior guard **Tyler Green** is sixth in the GNAC at 15.5 points per game and is among the national leaders in three-point shooting. He leads the league with 3.3 three-pointers made per game with a .435 three-point percentage. Junior forward **Melvin Newbern, Jr.**, is the third in GNAC in rebounding with 7.6 boards per game.

After finishing no better than seventh place in the program's first eight years in the conference, Simon Fraser used a brilliant second-half run to earn its first trip to the GNAC Championships. The No. 6 seed, the Clan went 7-3 in the final 10 games of the regular season, which included a road win over Saint Martin's and a home defeat of Northwest Nazarene. Another solid outside shooting team, Simon Fraser leads the GNAC with a .384 three-point percentage while averaging 78.6 points per game.

Sophomore center **Julian Roche** has led the Clan throughout the season, entering the tournament averaging 13.3 points per game. He is ranked fifth in the league with 6.6 rebounds per game. Junior guard **Othniel Spence** leads the team and is ninth in the GNAC with 13.7 points per game while junior guard **Michael Provenzano** leads the league with 4.9 assists per contest.

2018-19 GNAC Championships Participants

MONTANA STATE BILLINGS



- Montana State Billings earned its fifth trip to the GNAC Championships, and first since 2017, with a sweep at the Alaska schools last week, beating Alaska Anchorage 67-56 on Thursday and Alaska 92-65 on Saturday.
- In recognition of their efforts in the final week of the regular season, the Yellowjackets were named the GNAC Team of the Week.
- Freshman forward **Brendan Howard** led the Yellowjackets in his sixth-man role with 36 points and 11 rebounds on the road trip, shooting 66.7 percent from the field. Howard finished with 11 points and four rebounds at Alaska Anchorage before turning on for 25 points and seven rebounds at Alaska, making 10 of 13 from the field and 4 of 5 from the free throw line. Howard is fifth in the GNAC in scoring at 15.6 points per game.
- Senior guard/forward **Zack Rollins** contributed 29 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists in the two games. He finished with 10 points, four rebounds and four assists at Alaska Anchorage and then added 19 points, seven rebounds and three assists at Alaska. Rollins is averaging 14.1 points per game and his .847 free throw percentage is eighth in the GNAC.
- Junior guard **Tyler Green** continues to be one of the nation's top outside shooters, ranking 12th in Division II with 93 three-pointers made and 3.32 three-pointers made per game.
- Montana State Billings enters the GNAC Championships fourth in the GNAC with 79.5 points per game while averaging 35.6 rebounds per contest. The Yellowjackets rank fourth in the conference in field goal percentage (.469), blocked shots (3.25 per game) and assists (15.29 per game).

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene enters the GNAC Championships as the No. 3 seed after taking a 97-87 loss to Saint Martin's on Thursday and an 87-82 loss to Seattle Pacific on Saturday.
- The Nighthawks are in the GNAC Championships for just the second time, the first since the tournament's inaugural year in 2011. The team is assured its first overall record over .500 since that year.
- Senior guard **Obi Megwa** carried the Nighthawks with 52 points in the two games, making 52 percent of his shots from the field. Megwa led all scorers with 30 points against Saint Martin's connecting on 12 of 27 from the field to go with five rebounds and two steals. He then scored 22 points against Seattle Pacific, making 9 of 13 from the field. Megwa is second in the GNAC with 19.2 points per game and ranks third with 1.50 steals per game.
- Junior guard **Adonis Arms** added 48 points and had nine rebounds and six assists in the two games. Arms opened the week with 18 points against Saint Martin's on 6 of 16 from the field and 6 of 7 from the free throw line. He then posted a 30-point performance against Seattle Pacific, going 10 of 21 from the field and 9 of 9 from the free throw line. Arms leads the GNAC with 20.9 points per game and is second with 1.96 steals per game.
- Junior guard **Jayden Bezzant** scored 29 points in the home finales, paced by his 15 points against Seattle Pacific on 7 of 10 from the field. Bezzant is averaging 12.8 points per game, primarily coming off the bench.
- Northwest Nazarene leads the GNAC with 85 points per game and ranks second with 37.7 rebounds per game. The Nighthawks also lead the league and rank 14th in Division II with a .502 field goal percentage. The team leads the GNAC in field goal defense (.418) and is second in blocked shots (4.08 per game).

SAINT MARTIN'S



- Saint Martin's captured the program's first GNAC regular-season championship with a 97-87 road win over Northwest Nazarene on Thursday and a 105-96 double-overtime win at Central Washington on Saturday.
- The Saints are in the GNAC Championships for the fifth time and for the fourth consecutive year. Saint Martin's advanced to last year's final before earning a berth in the NCAA Division II West Regional.
- Senior guard **Luke Chavez** came up big in the final week of the regular season with 56 points and 12 rebounds in the two games, shooting 51.7 percent from the field and 18 of 19 from the free throw line to earn GNAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors. Chavez led the Saints with 23 points and seven rebounds at Northwest Nazarene. He then led all scorers with 33 points at Central Washington, connecting on 11 of 18 from the field, 5 of 11 from three-point range and 6 of 6 from the free throw line. Chavez shares top scoring honors for the Saints at 13.2 points per game and is fifth with a .864 free throw percentage.
- Sophomore guard **BJ Standley** stepped in the absence of senior guard EJ Boyce, finishing with 49 points and shot 57.6 percent from the field on the road trip. Standley scored 20 points off the bench at Northwest Nazarene, connecting on 7 of 9 from the field and 4 of 4 from the free throw line. He then went off for 29 points at Central Washington on 8 of 17 from the field and 11 of 14 from the free throw line to go with five rebounds and six assists. Standley is averaging 11.2 points per game and is second in the GNAC with a .883 free throw percentage.
- Saint Martin's enters the GNAC Championships averaging 78.5 points and 34.4 rebounds per game. The Saints lead the GNAC and rank 25th in Division II with 10.6 three-pointers made per game and are 26th in Division II with 296 three-pointers made. Saint Martin's also leads the GNACX and is 25th in Division II in three-point defense (.319).
- Saint Martin's moved up three spots to No. 14 in the NABC Division II Coaches Poll and two spots to No. 8 in the D2SIDA Media Poll. The Saints are No. 1 in the first NCAA Division II West Region Rankings for the second straight week with the next rankings being released on Wednesday.

Around The GNAC

SEATTLE PACIFIC



- Seattle Pacific, the GNAC Championships No. 2 seed, enters the tournament on a 10-game win streak after posting a 74-62 win at Central Washington on Thursday and an 87-82 victory at Northwest Nazarene on Saturday.
- The Falcons are in the GNAC Championships for the eighth time in the tournament's nine years. It is the seventh time that SPU has been a No. 3 seed or higher.
- Junior guard **Gavin Long** led the Falcons in the road trip with 36 points and 14 rebounds while connecting on 15 of 20 from the free throw line. Long finished with 15 points and four rebounds at Central Washington, making 7 of 8 from the free throw line. Long then led SPU with 21 points and 10 rebounds in the win at Northwest Nazarene, going 6 of 12 from the field and 8 of 12 from the free throw line. Long is the Falcons' leading scorer at 13.4 points per game.
- Senior guard **Nikhil Lizotte** added 26 points in the two games. He led the Falcons with 23 points at Northwest Nazarene, connecting on 6 of 11 from the field, 4 of 7 from three-point range and 7 of 8 from the free throw line. Lizotte is averaging 12.9 points per game and is fourth in the GNAC with a .878 free throw percentage.
- Senior forward **Coleman Wooten** topped his week with 16 points and 10 rebounds against Central Washington, connecting on 7 of 12 from the field. Wooten closed out the regular season averaging 12.2 points per game and is second in the GNAC with 7.8 rebounds per game.
- Seattle Pacific is averaging 78.9 points per game and leads the GNAC with 38.4 rebounds per game. The Falcons lead the GNAC and rank ninth in Division II in rebound margin (8.5). They also lead the GNAC in rebounding defense (29.8 per game) and second in field goal percentage (.486).
- Seattle Pacific jumped from No. 5 to No. 3 in the second NCAA Division II West Region Rankings of the season. The Falcons also received five votes in both the NABC Division II Coaches Poll and D2SIDA Media Poll.

SIMON FRASER



- Simon Fraser earned its first GNAC Championships berth thanks to a 76-73 win on Tuesday over Western Washington that allowed the Clan to claim a tiebreaker. The team closed the week with an 84-72 loss to Concordia on Thursday and a 68-56 loss to Western Oregon on Saturday.
- With a 15-13 record entering the championships, Simon Fraser has assured itself the program's first winning record since joining the GNAC in 2010. The team's nine conference wins are the most in that span by three games.
- Sophomore forward **Jasdeep Singh** led the Clan with 61 points and 21 rebounds in the three games. He came up big against Western Washington with 31 points and seven rebounds, connecting on 12 of 18 from the field and 4 of 6 from three-point range. Singh then scored 17 points against Concordia and 13 points against Western Oregon. Singh enters the week averaging 11.3 points per game and leads the GNAC with a .494 three-point percentage (38-77).
- Freshman guard **Wilfried Balata** finished with 56 points and 27 rebounds in the three games, shooting 42.5 percent from the field and 13 of 17 from the free throw line. His week was topped by 30 points and 16 rebounds against Concordia, connecting on 11 of 26 from the field and 7 of 9 from the free throw line. Balata is 11th in the GNAC with 13.5 points per game.
- Junior guard **Othniel Spence** connected for 40 points in the three games, headlined by his 17 points against Concordia. Spence is the Clan's leading scorer, ranking ninth in the GNAC at 13.7 points per game. He is also fourth in the GNAC with 1.44 steals per game.

- Simon Fraser enters the week averaging 78.6 points per game and is fourth in the GNAC with 36.4 rebounds per game. The Clan leads the GNAC with a .384 three-point percentage and ranks second with 15.54 assists per game. Junior guard **Michael Provenzano** leads the conference individually with 4.93 assists per game.

WESTERN OREGON



- The No. 4 seed in the GNAC Championships, Western Oregon is the defending tournament champion. The Wolves ended the regular season with a road split, taking a 79-69 loss at Western Washington on Thursday before scoring a 68-56 win at Simon Fraser on Saturday.
- Western Oregon is in the GNAC Championships for the eighth time and for the sixth consecutive year. The Wolves won the tournament in 2015 and 2017.
- Junior guard **Dalven Brushier** led the Wolves with 30 points in the two games, making 56.2 percent of his shots from the field. After scoring 11 points at Western Washington, Brushier led all scorers with 19 points at Simon Fraser to go with six rebounds, four assists and two steals. He made 5 of 10 from the field, 3 of 4 from three-point range and 6 of 6 from the free throw line. Brushier is averaging 11.3 points per game.
- Junior forward **Riley Hawken** finished with 27 points and 16 rebounds in the two contests. He finished just short of a double-double with 15 points and nine rebounds at Western Washington before connecting for 12 points and seven rebounds at Simon Fraser. Hawken leads the Wolves in scoring at 12.3 points per game and is sixth in the GNAC with 6.5 rebounds per game.
- Western Oregon enters the week averaging 77.8 points and 35.7 rebounds per game. The Wolves lead the GNAC and rank 22nd in Division II in scoring defense (65.7 points allowed per game). Western Oregon is 22nd in Division II in scoring margin (12.1), ninth in turnovers per game (10.0) and 17th in fewest turnovers (290).
- Western Oregon dropped one spot to No. 10 in the second NCAA Division II West Region Rankings of the season.

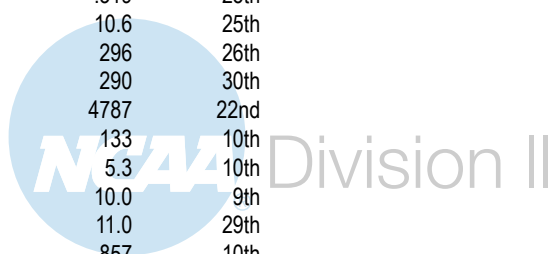
