**#StormFront** Due to the forecast for heavy rain in the Puget Sound region, the GNAC Championships was moved on Monday to Ellensburg from its original site, Saint Martin's University.

**#CarlosCycle** Western Oregon's **Logan Carlos** hit for the cycle in Sunday's 15-4 season-finale win. She became just the fifth GNAC player since 2014 to accomplish the feat. She shared the GNAC Player of the Week award.

**Maia McNicoll, Northwest Nazarene**  
**UT • 5-5 • Junior • Kaneohe, Hawaii**

McNicoll batted .533 for the Nighthawks in the four-game series with Simon Fraser, going 8 for 15 with three runs, two doubles, a triple, a home run and 13 RBI. McNicoll went 2 for 4 with a pair of RBI singles in Friday's 5-0 opening game win and then went 1 for 4 with an RBI single in the 10-7 nightcap loss. She went 2 for 3 with an RBI double in the 10-1, five-inning opening game win on Saturday and closed by going 3 for 4 while tying a GNAC record with eight RBI and a grand slam in the 13-4, five-inning second game win.



**Logan Carlos, Western Oregon**  
**SS/2B • 5-2 • Senior • Mililani, Hawaii**

Carlos batted .500 in the Wolves' series victory over Western Oregon, going 7 for 14 with five runs scored and five RBI. She became just the fifth GNAC player to hit for the cycle since 2014, and the first since 2020, by going 4 for 5 in the final game on Sunday, a 15-4, five-inning win. Carlos also went 2 for 3 with an RBI single in Saturday's 10-2, six-inning win and went 1 for 2 in Sunday's opening game loss.

Doan amassed a 0.44 earned run average in two starts and three appearances, winning both starts. Doan allowed one run on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts en route to a 6-1 win in the second game on Friday. She opened Sunday with a four-hit shutout in the 4-0 victory, walking two and striking out five. Doan closed the week by throwing two innings of relief in the nightcap, allowing one hit and striking out three. For the week, Doan allowed one run on nine hits and struck out 13.

# GNAC Championships Preview

ELLENSBURG, Wash. – Northwest Nazarene hopes that the momentum they built in April carries through into May as the Nighthawks are the No. 1 seed in the GNAC Softball Championships, which begin Thursday at Frederick Field on the campus of Central Washington University.

With a 30-18 overall record and 18-6 conference mark, Northwest Nazarene secured its second consecutive regular-season championship and its fourth straight GNAC Championships appearance with an impressive run through the final half of the season. The Nighthawks went 13-3 against conference foes, which included series sweeps over Montana State Billings and Western Oregon and a series victory over Simon Fraser.

Northwest Nazarene excels in the circle, leading the GNAC with a 2.58 earned run average with the fewest earned runs (116) and walks (97) allowed in the conference. Sophomore **Sidney Booth** leads the conference with her 1.91 ERA, 15 wins and 184 strikeouts in 164.2 innings. She is among the Division II leaders with 23 complete games. Booth also helps herself at the plate, ranking second in the GNAC with a .390 batting average.

Senior **Tori Hensley** provides a solid second look in the circle, ranking sixth in the GNAC with a 3.38 ERA and eight wins in 74.2 innings. Freshman **Charlotte Forniss** has been effective as well with a 3.30 ERA in 39 innings as a part-time starter.

Senior **Ivy Hommel** ranks eighth in the conference with a .368 batting average and leads the GNAC with 54 runs scored. She is among six NNU players batting .300 or better. Sophomore **Abigail Gagnon** is batting .308 and junior **Maia McNicoll**, who is tied for first in the GNAC with 11 home runs, is batting .307.

With a 29-18 overall record and 17-7 GNAC mark, Saint Martin's is in the midst of its best season since 2017. The Saints were in contention for the regular-season title right up until the final weekend before NNU surged ahead with its series win over Simon Fraser. The Saints put together a solid April, going 11-5 in conference games after posting an 11-game win streak earlier in the season.

The Saints have also benefitted from solid pitching, ranking third in the GNAC with a 3.69 earned run average. Sophomore **Tia Ridings** has been the team's ace, ranking 10th in the conference with a 3.56 earned run average with eight wins and 101 strikeouts in 22 starts. Freshman **Chloe Leverington** has been impressive, earning 12 wins while ranking third in the conference with a 2.32 ERA. She has allowed the fewest walks (13) of any qualified pitcher over 99 innings, primarily in relief appearances.

At the plate, sophomore **Malia Pinder** is fourth in the GNAC with her .387 batting average and ranks tied for sixth with 55 hits. Sophomore **Megan Convery** has a .313 average in 32 games while sophomore **Vanessa Smoke** is batting .289.

Western Washington dominated the 2021 GNAC Championships, allowing one run on five hits in three games to win the title. Entering as the No. 3 seed in 2022, the Vikings have a solid combination of veteran leadership and young talent that will make them a threat once again. The Vikings solidified their spot early in the season, going 9-3 in the first three conference series of the season en route to a 29-22 overall record and 15-9 conference mark.

Also a solid pitching team, the Vikings rank second in the GNAC with a 3.15 earned run average. Senior **Kira Doan** has provided solid leadership, ranking fourth in the conference with a 2.57 ERA. Her 13 wins are second in the conference only to Booth. Sophomore **Sydney Brown** ranks second in the GNAC with a 2.26 ERA. Her eight wins on the season includes a no-hitter thrown against Academy of Art during the Tournament of Champions on Apr. 3.



Senior **Chantelle Shimabukuro** leads the WWU offense, ranking third in the GNAC with a .389 batting average. Senior **Dakota Brooks** is batting .366 with a team-leading 39 RBI and a .625 slugging percentage. Senior **Tatum Dow** is batting .349. Dow and Brooks are tied for third in the GNAC with 59 hits.

After withdrawing from the 2021 tournament due to COVID protocols, Central Washington looks forward to its eighth GNAC Championships berth. The Wildcats secured their spot on the final day of the season, holding off a scrappy Western Oregon squad for the No. 4 seed. Central enters the tournament with a 19-25 overall record and 10-14 conference mark under

first-year coach **Joe DiPietro**.

The Wildcats' strength has been at the plate with a .288 team batting average. Junior **Allie Thiessen** leads the way, ranking fifth with a .381 batting average. Junior **Alyssa Benthagen** has a .312 average and is tied for the conference lead with 11 home runs. Sophomore **Makenna King** is batting .333.

Senior **Rhane Harris** has been the Wildcats' stalwart in the circle with 11 wins. She ranks sixth in the conference with a 3.11 earned run average and her 15 complete games rank second in the conference. Senior **Isabel Womack** owns a 4.37 ERA in 21 appearances.

Originally scheduled to be played on the campus of Saint Martin's University in Lacey, Washington, the tournament was moved on Monday due to the forecast for heavy rain in the Puget Sound region and the prospect of unplayable field conditions.

The GNAC Championships open on Thursday with No. 2 Saint Martin's facing No. 3 Western Washington at 10 a.m. No. 1 Northwest Nazarene will play No. 4 Central Washington at 12:30 p.m., with the losers of the two games playing in an elimination contest that day at 3 p.m.

The double-elimination tournament ends with the championship game on Saturday at noon. The winner of the GNAC Championships receives the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Championships.

# GNAC Championships Participating Teams

## CENTRAL WASHINGTON



- Central Washington qualified for the GNAC Championships on the final day of the regular season thanks to an 8-5 win over Western Oregon in Sunday's opener. The Wolves took the series, winning 5-4 and 10-2 (six innings) on Saturday and 15-4 (five innings) in the second game on Sunday.
- Sophomore **Makenna King** led the Wildcats offensively with a .400 batting average, going 4 for 10 with two runs scored, a double and two RBI. King went 1 for 2 with a run scored in both Saturday games. She then went 2 for 4 with a run scored and a two-run double in Sunday's win. King enters the week with a .333 batting average.
- Junior **Harlee Carpenter** went .385 in the four games, going 5 for 13 with three runs scored and three RBI. Carpenter went 1 for 3 in both Saturday games with an RBI fielder's choice in the first game and a sacrifice fly in the second game. On Sunday, Carpenter went 1 for 3 in the opener with an RBI single and ended by going 2 for 3 in the nightcap with an RBI single. Carpenter is batting .309 on the season.
- Senior **Rhane Harris** earned the win in the circle on Sunday, allowing three runs, two earned, on 12 hits with two walks and a strikeout. Harris has 11 wins on the season and is sixth in the GNAC with a 3.37 earned run average.
- Central Washington enters the GNAC Championships with a .288 batting average and a 4.26 earned run average.
- This marks the eighth time that CWU has qualified for the GNAC Championships, including the last six years. In 2021, CWU earned the No. 2 seed but withdrew due to COVID health & safety protocols.

## NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene earned its second consecutive regular-season championship by taking three of four games from Simon Fraser. The Nighthawks won the opener on Friday 5-0 before dropping the nightcap 10-7. They won both games on Saturday in five innings, 10-1 and 14-3.
- Junior **Maia McNicoll** shared GNAC Softball Player of the Week honors after she batted .533 in the series, going 8 for 15 with three runs, two doubles, a triple, a home run and 13 RBI. In Saturday's finale, McNicoll went 3 for 4, falling a single short of the cycle, and tied the GNAC single-game record with eight RBI. Four of those came on a game-ending grand slam. She went 2 for 4 with three RBI in Friday's opener, 1 for 4 in the Saturday nightcap and 2 for 3 in Saturday's opener. McNicoll is batting .307 on the season. She is 10th in Division II with 61 RBI and 14th with five sacrifice flies.
- Senior **Ivy Hommel** finished with a .429 batting average in the series, going 6 for 14 with eight runs, a double, two triples, a home run and six RBI. Hommel had a hit in each game of the series, going 2 for 4 with a triple and a two-run homer in Saturday's opener and going 2 for 3 with two runs, a double and a triple in the nightcap. Hommel is seventh in the GNAC with a .368 batting average and is 25th in Division II with 1.12 runs per game.
- Sophomore **Sidney Booth** earned two wins in her two starts. She threw a three-hit shutout in Friday's opener, walking two and striking out seven. Booth then allowed one run on five hits with a walk and seven strikeouts in Saturday's opener. Booth leads the GNAC with a 1.91 earned run average and is second with a .390 batting average. She is third in Division II with 23 complete games.
- Northwest Nazarene leads the conference with a 2.58 earned run average is second in with a .296 batting average. The Nighthawks are ranked ninth in Division II with 190 walks drawn.
- The Nighthawks qualified for the GNAC Championships for the fourth consecutive year. They won in 2018, beating Simon Fraser in the final 1-0. Northwest Nazarene advanced to the final in 2021, falling to Western Washington 3-1.

## SAINT MARTIN'S



- Saint Martin's ended the regular season with a split at Western Washington. The Saints won Friday's opener 3-2 and dropped the nightcap 6-1. After losing game one on Sunday, 4-0, the Saints came back for the 8-3 victory.
- Junior **Kylee Vanderbout** led the Saints offensively with a .429 batting average, going 6 for 14 with three runs and two RBI. Vanderbout singled in the game-winning run in Friday's opener and then went 2 for 3 in the nightcap. She closed the series by going 3 for 4 in the nightcap with two runs scored and an RBI. Vanderbout enters the week with a .310 batting average.
- Sophomore **Malia Pinder** finished the series with a .273 batting average. Her best outing came in Friday's opener when she went 2 for 3 and RBI single. Freshman **Kekai Schultz** batted .231 with hits in each of the final three games.
- Sophomore **Tia Ridings** went 1-1 in her starts in the circle. She was the complete-game winner on Sunday, allowing three runs, two earned, on 11 hits and two walks with four strikeouts. Ridings threw the first five innings of Friday's opener before giving way to freshman **Chloe Leverington**, who allowed three hits and struck out two in two innings for her 11th win of the year. Ridings is 10th in the GNAC with a 3.62 earned run average. Leverington is third with a 2.32 ERA, is 11th in Division II with a 7.85 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 20th with 0.91 walks allowed per seven innings.
- Saint Martin's is third in the GNAC with a 3.69 earned run average and enters the week with a .273 batting average.
- Saint Martin's is in the GNAC Championships for the seventh time. The Saints qualified in 2021, going 0-2. The Saints won the inaugural GNAC Championships in 2013.

## WESTERN WASHINGTON



- Western Washington closed the regular season with a home split against Saint Martin's. After dropping Friday's opener, 3-2, the Vikings won the nightcap 6-1 and took the Sunday opener 4-0. The Vikings won the finale 8-3.
- Senior **Kira Doan** was named the GNAC Pitcher of the Week after she picked up both wins for the Vikings, allowing one run on nine hits with 13 strikeouts in 16 innings. Doan allowed one run on four hits and two walks while striking out five to earn the win in Friday's nightcap. She came back to win Sunday's opener with a four-hit shutout, walking two and striking out five. She closed out the finale by allowing one hit and striking out three in the final two innings. Doan is fourth in the GNAC with a 2.57 earned run average and her 13 wins ranks second.
- Senior **Dakota Brooks** led the WWU offense with a .400 batting average, going 6 for 15 with two runs scored, two doubles and an RBI. She went 2 for 4 in Friday's opener with an RBI single. She closed the week by going 3 for 4 in Sunday's finale with a run scored. Brooks ranks seventh in the GNAC with a .369 batting average and leads the conference with 16 doubles.
- Freshman **Kanilehua Pitoy** also batted .400 in the series, going 6 for 15 with three runs scored and an RBI. Pitoy went 3 for 4 in Friday's second-game win with an RBI single in the second. She finished by going 2 for 4 in Sunday's nightcap with a run scored. Pitoy is batting .296 on the season.
- Western Washington enters the week second in the GNAC with a 3.15 earned run average and is third with a .293 batting average. The Vikings rank 23rd in Division II with 85 doubles.
- The Vikings are in their fifth GNAC Championships and are the defending champion. Western Washington also won the title in 2017. In 2021, the Vikings put together an impressive performance, allowing just one run on five hits en route to the championship.
