#CamronLeadsTheWay Central Washington's **Camron McNeil** averaged 27 points per game in two wins to earn GNAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors.

#NewChampion There will be a new champion in 2023 as the GNAC Championships run Thursday through Saturday in Bellingham. The tournament returns to its six-team format after all 10 teams played last year in a COVID-19 adjustment.

McNeil averaged 27 points per game and shot 62.9% from the field and 61.5% from three-point range to lead the Wildcats to two critical road wins that earned CWU the No. 4 seed in the GNAC Championships. McNeil led all scorers with 25 points in Thursday's 77-75 upset at Saint Martin's.

He connected on 11 of 17 from the field and 3 of 7

from three-point range. McNeil was once again the leading scorer with 29 points in Saturday's 75-73 win at Western Oregon. He made 11 of 18 from the field and 5 of 6 from long range to go with three rebounds and two steals.

GNAC Men's Basketball Championships Preview

BELLINGHAM, Wash. – For the second year in a row, Saint Martin's leads the field for the GNAC Men's Basketball Championships, presented by Under Armour, which begin on Thursday at Western Washington University's Carver Gym.

But unlike last year, the Saints hope that the coveted No. 1 seed in the tournament will not result in an early exit.

In last year's tournament, a 10-team affair held in Lacey, the top-seeded Saints bowed out in a loss to Western Oregon in the quarterfinals. It is not a new trend as the last three years have seen the No. 1 seed eliminated. In the 12 years of the tournament, the No. 1 seed has hoisted the trophy just five times.

After going 25-3 during the regular season with a 15-3 conference mark, and with many of the same players that led the team to the top in 2022, the Saints hope that they can buck the top-seed trend in 2023.

Saint Martin's has been an offensive juggernaut all season, ranking second in the GNAC with 81.8 points per game while leading the league in scoring margin (+11.8), assists (17.43 per game) and three-pointers made per game (11.14). The team's 28.9 three-point attempts per game rank 10th in Division II. The Saints also lead the conference with 37.5 rebounds per game and are second in offensive boards.

Junior guard **Kyle Greeley** is SMU's top scorer, ranking fifth in the GNAC with 15.4 points per game, while junior guard Tyke Thompson is ninth in rebounding at 5.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard **Jaden Nielsen-Skinner** has been a spark plug for the offense, averaging 10.1 points per game while ranking second in the conference in assists (6.43 per game) and third in steals (1.75 per game).

Prolific from outside, the Saints boast three of the top-10 shooters in the GNAC in three-point percentage, led by Greeley and **Branden Bunn** at 42.6%.

Montana State Billings, the No. 2 seed, is experiencing its best season since joining the GNAC in 2007. The Yellowjackets' 20 wins are the program's most since 2012-13 and is the first 20-win season since 2005-06. While the second-place GNAC finish is the best in program history, MSUB will aim to win the GNAC Championships for the first time since 2012, when it won it all as the No. 5 seed.

While averaging just 68.5 points per game, eighth in the conference, MSUB has excelled on the defensive end by limiting opponents to 67.5 points per contest and ranks third in the GNAC in field goal percentage defense (.432).

Senior guard **Carrington Wiggins** continues to be one of the top scoring threats in the conference, ranking second in the GNAC with 18.1 points per game and fifth with 2.07 three-pointers made per contest. His free-throw percentage of .918, making 112 out of 122 attempts, is among the top 10 in Division II.

Senior forward **Bilal Shabazz** is one of just two players to rank in the GNAC top 10 in both scoring and rebounding. His 8.6 rebounds per game rank second while his 13 points per game rank ninth. One of the top defensive players in the conference, he leads the GNAC with 7.21 defensive rebounds per game and ranks fourth with 1.21 blocks per game.

Seattle Pacific, the No. 3 seed, is in the GNAC Championships for the 11th time in program history, the most of any of the six teams in the field. The Falcons' hallmark has been solid shooting, ranking third in the conference with 79.6 points per game. Among Division II teams, SPU ranks among the top five in field goal percentage (.507) and free-throw percentage (.770), leading the GNAC in both categories.



Junior forward **Shaw Anderson** has led the GNAC in scoring for most of the season, averaging 19.8 points per game. Anderson also ranks among the top free-throwers in the conference at 85.1%. Sophomore guard **Zack Paulsen** is averaging 11.7 points per game and is third in the GNAC with a .888 free-throw percentage. Sophomore forward **Kelton Samore** ranks third in the conference in field goal shooting at 62.6%.

Central Washington used an exciting late-season run to secure the No. 4 seed. The Wildcats won their last four regular-season games, including a 77-75 upset of Saint Martin's on Thursday in Lacey, and emerged on top of a three-way tie for fourth place at 9-9. Central won those final four games by a combined total of 11 points, which included three two-point victories. The Wildcats advanced to the 2022 GNAC Championships final, where they were upset by eventual West Region finalist Alaska.

Central Washington averages 74.1 points per game, ranks second in the GNAC with a .485 field goal percentage and third with 15.89 assists per game.

Junior guard **Camron McNeil** leads the Wildcats offensively, ranking fourth in the GNAC with 15.4 points per game while ranking seventh with 1.96 three-pointers made per game. Senior forward **Matt Poquette** is the other player in the GNAC top 10 in scoring and rebounding, ranking third with 6.7 points per game and 10th with 13 points per game. Senior guard **Brock Gilbert** ranks in the Division II top five in assists with seven per game.

Western Oregon also benefitted from a late surge to secure the No. 5 seed, winning three of their last five games of the regular season. The Wolves enter the tournament averaging 73.4 points per game and rank third in the conference with 7.80 steals per game.

Senior guard **Cameron Cranston**, the GNAC Preseason Player of the Year, ranks third in the conference in scoring at 16.7 points per game and is fifth with a .851 free-throw percentage. Senior forward **John Morrill-Keeler** ranks fourth in the GNAC with 6.4 rebounds per game while junior forward **Cameron Benzel** ranks second in field goal shooting at 63.4%.

Northwest Nazarene, the No. 6 seed, is making its fourth consecutive GNAC Championships appearance and is looking for its first win in the tournament since 2019. While averaging 66.1 points per game, 10th in the conference, the Nighthawks lead the GNAC with 66.4 points allowed per game, are second with a .430 field goal percentage defense and rank third with 37.1 rebounds per game.

Sophomore guard **Tru Allen** paces NNU offensively with 12.4 points per game and ranks second in the GNAC with 1.88 steals per game. Junior forward **Gabriel Murphy** leads the conference with 8.8 rebounds per game and is among the Division II leaders with 3.52 offensive boards per contest.

The GNAC Men's Basketball Championships begin with the quarterfinals on Thursday. No. 3 Seattle Pacific and No. 6 Northwest Nazarene square off at noon with No. 4 Central Washington facing No. 5 Western Oregon playing at 2:15 p.m.

The winner of the Seattle Pacific/Northwest Nazarene game will face No. 2 Montana State Billings in the semifinals on Friday at noon. The winner of the Central Washington/Western Oregon game will face No. 1 Saint Martin's at 2:15 p.m. The championship game will be on Saturday at 5 p.m.

The winner of the GNAC Championships receives the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Division II Championships.

CENTRAL WASHINGTON



WILDCATS

- Central Washington earned the No. 4 seed in the GNAC Championships with a big sweep last week, taking a 77-75 win at Saint Martin's on Thursday and a 75-073 victory at Western Oregon on Saturday.
- Junior guard **Camron McNeil** was named the GNAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week after he averaged 27 points per game in the two wins, shooting 62.9% from the field and 61.5% from three-point range. He led all scorers in both games. McNeil finished with 25 points at Saint Martin's on 11 of 17 from the field and 3 of 7 from three-point range. At Western Oregon, McNeil finished with 29 points on 11 of 18 from the field, 5 of 6 from three-point range and 2 of 2 from the free-throw line. McNeil ranks fourth in the GNAC with 15.4 points per game.
- Senior forward **Matt Poquette** averaged 14 points and 7.5 rebounds per game, shooting 50% from the field. Poquette opened the week with a 15-point, six-rebounds performance at Saint Martin's where he shot 5 of 9 from the field. He added 13 points and nine rebounds at Western Oregon. Poquette is averaging 13 points per game and ranks third in the GNAC with 6.7 rebounds per game.
- Junior forward **Samaad Hector** averaged eight points and 6.5 rebounds per game. His week was topped by a 10-point, six-rebound performance at Western Oregon, which included the game-winning three-pointer with one second left.
- Central Washington enters the GNAC Championships averaging 74.1 points and 34.7 rebounds per game. The Wildcats rank second in the GNAC and 27th in Division II with a .485 field goal percentage.
- The Wildcats are 7-6 all-time at the GNAC Championships and are in the tournament for just the second time since 2018. They won the first tournament in 2011 and advanced to the final in 2022, falling 72-57 to Alaska.

MONTANA STATE BILLINGS



- Montana State Billings closed the regular season with a split at home, beating Alaska 60-59 on Thursday before taking a 70-61 loss to Alaska Anchorage on Saturday.
- Senior guard **Carrington Wiggins** averaged 18.5 points and five rebounds per game, shooting 55.6% from the field. Wiggins scored 18 points against Alaska on 8 of 17 from the field to go with four rebounds, three assists and two steals. Wiggins led all scorers with 19 points against Alaska Anchorage on 7 of 10 from the field and 2 of 4 from three-point range. Wiggins is second in the GNAC in scoring at 18.1 points per game. He leads the conference with 1.89 steals per game and is also first in the GNAC and sixth in Division II with a .918 free-throw percentage.
- Senior forward **Bilal Shabazz** averaged 18 points and 10.5 rebounds per game, shooting 50% from the field. He posted his ninth and 10th double-doubles of the season in the contests, finishing with 19 points and 10 rebounds against Alaska to go with 17 points and 11 rebounds against Alaska Anchorage. He also had five assists against the Seawolves. Shabazz is ninth in the GNAC with 13 points per game and second with 8.6 rebounds per game. He ranks 25th in Division II with 10 double-doubles.
- Junior guard **Steven Richardson** averaged 9.5 points per game. His best effort came on Saturday with a 12-point performance against Alaska Anchorage. Richardson enters the week averaging 10.4 points per game.
- Montana State Billings is averaging 66.1 points and 33.8 rebounds per game. The Yellowjackets rank third in the GNAC in scoring defense, allowing 67.5 points per game, and rank 22nd in Division II in fewest fouls with 13.9 per game.
- Montana State Billings is 3-6 all-time in the GNAC Championships and is looking for its first tournament game victory since 2012. The Yellowjackets went 3-0 that season, winning it all as the No. 5 seed.

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene dropped both of its final games of the regular season, 65-63 at Western Oregon on Thursday and 58-55 game Saint Martin's on Saturday.
- Sophomore guard **Ryzi Bergerson** led NNU with an average of 10.5 points per game. He opened the week leading the Nighthawks with 12 points and four rebounds at Western Oregon, including 3 of 9 from three-point range. Bergerson added nine points at Saint Martin's. Bergerson enters the GNAC Championships averaging 10.3 points per game.
- Sophomore forward **Aaron Murphy** averaged 10 points and six rebounds per game off the bench. Murphy finished with seven points and six rebounds in 22 minutes at Western Oregon. He led the Nighthawks with 13 points and six rebounds at Saint Martin's on 5 of 9 from the field. Murphy is averaging 6.2 points and 4.7 rebounds per game.
- Sophomore **Timothy TenKley** averaged 7.5 points per game and shot 75% from the field and 60% from three-point range. He finished with seven points at Western Oregon before scoring eight points at Saint Martin's, making 3 of 4 from the field in both games.
- Northwest Nazarene enters the GNAC Championships averaging 66.1 points and 37.1 rebounds per game. The Nighthawks rank second in the GNAC with a .430 opponent field goal percentage. They lead the conference and rank 16th in Division II with 13.1 offensive rebounds per game.
- Northwest Nazarene is 3-5 all-time in the GNAC Championships and is making its fourth straight tournament appearance.

SAINT MARTIN'S



- Despite seeing its nine-game win streak end with a 77-75 loss to Central Washington on Thursday, Saint Martin's claimed its second straight regular-season championship with a 58-55 victory over Northwest Nazarene on Saturday.
- Junior guard **Tyke Thompson** averaged 13 points and five rebounds per game to lead the Saints, shooting 50% from both the field and three-point range. Thompson finished with seven points and eight rebounds against Central Washington. He then led all scorers with 19 points against Northwest Nazarene on 6 of 9 from the field, 3 of 5 from three-point range and 4 of 4 from the free-throw line. Thompson is averaging 11 points per game and ranks ninth in the GNAC with 5.7 rebounds per game.
- Junior guard **Kyle Greeley** averaged 12.5 points per game and made 52.9% from the field in the two games. Greeley came off the bench to score 10 points against Central Washington on 4 of 8 from the field. He added a 15-point performance against Northwest Nazarene on 5 of 9 from the field. Greeley ranks fifth in the GNAC with 14.4 points per game and is fifth with a .560 field goal percentage.
- Sophomore guard **Jaden Nielsen-Skinner** averaged 10.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and nine assists per game. He opened the week with a double-double of 15 points and 12 assists with seven rebounds against Central Washington. He added six points, six assists and four rebounds against Northwest Nazarene. Nielsen-Skinner averages 10.1 points per game. He ranks seventh in Division II with 6.4 assists per game.
- Saint Martin's ranks second in the GNAC with 81.8 points per game. The Saints lead the conference and rank 13th in Division II with 17.4 assists per game and is also seventh in Division II with 11.1 three-pointers made per game.
- The Saints are 3-5 all-time in the GNAC Championships. They will be looking for their first tournament wins since 2018 when it went 2-1 and advanced to the GNAC Championships final.

GNAC Championships Participants

SEATTLE PACIFIC



- Seattle Pacific enters the GNAC Championships on a three-way win streak after collecting a 72-71 victory from Alaska Anchorage on Thursday and beating Alaska, 60-51, on Saturday.

- Junior forward **Shaw Anderson** led the Falcons with averages of 18.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game.

Anderson led all scorers with 20 points against Alaska Anchorage, connecting on 8 of 20 from the field, to go with five rebounds. He finished with 17 points and eight rebounds against Alaska. Anderson leads the GNAC in scoring at 19.8 points per game and is sixth with a .851 free-throw percentage.

- Junior guard **Ben Baker-McCann** came off the bench to average 11 points and seven rebounds per game, making 53.3% from the field. Baker-McCann finished with 10 points and five rebounds against Alaska Anchorage, connecting on 4 of 7 from the field. He then finished with 12 points and nine rebounds against Alaska, making 4 of 8 from the field. Baker-McCann is averaging 6.9 points and five rebounds per game.

- Sophomore forward **Kelton Samore** averaged nine points per game and shot 70% from the field. His week was topped by a 17-point performance against Alaska Anchorage on 7 of 8 from the field. Samore enters the GNAC Championships averaging 10.1 points per game and ranks third in the GNAC with a .626 field goal percentage

- Seattle Pacific is averaging 79.6 points and 32.9 rebounds per game. The Falcons lead the conference and rank eighth in Division II with a .507 field goal percentage. They also lead the GNAC and rank 28th in Division II with a .770 free-throw percentage.

- Seattle Pacific is 11-6 all-time in the GNAC Championships and is making its 11th tournament appearance. The Falcons are looking for their first win since 2019 when they won the GNAC Championships in Bellingham.

WESTERN OREGON



- Western Oregon split a pair of home games to complete the regular season, beating Northwest Nazarene 65-63 on Thursday before taking a 75-73 loss to Central Washington on Saturday.

- Junior forward **Cameron Benzel** averaged 14 points and shot 90% from the field, 75% from three-point range and 87.5% from the free-throw line in the two games. Benzel did his most damage against Northwest Nazarene, leading WOU with 19 points on 6 of 7 from the field, 2 of 3 from long range and 5 of 6 from the free-throw line. He added a nine-point performance against Central Washington on 3 of 3 from the field. Benzel is averaging 11.7 points per game and ranks second in the GNAC with a .634 field goal percentage.

- Senior guard **Cameron Cranston** averaged 13 points per game. Cranston finished with 12 points against Northwest Nazarene before connecting for a team-high 14 points against Central Washington on 5 of 12 from the field and 3 of 5 from three-point range. Cranston is third in the GNAC in scoring with 16.7 points per game.

- Senior forward **John Morrill-Keeler** contributed 10.5 points and seven rebounds per game. His week included a double-double of 13 points and 10 rebounds against Northwest Nazarene and an eight-point performance against Central Washington. Morrill-Keeler is averaging 10.3 points per game and ranks fourth in the GNAC with 6.4 rebounds per game.

- Western Oregon is averaging 73.4 points and 34.4 rebounds per game. The Wolves rank third in the GNAC with a .478 field goal percentage and 7.80 steals per game.

- Western Oregon is 11-8 all-time at the GNAC Championships and has appeared in all but one tournament. The Wolves went 2-1 last year, losing 65-64 in the semifinals to Central Washington.
