GNAC Championships Preview

SEATTLE, Wash. – Alaska Anchorage is no stranger to the postseason.

The Seawolves enter as the No. 1 seed in the 2020 GNAC Women's Basketball Championships, beginning on Thursday at Seattle Pacific's Royal Brougham Pavilion. The Seawolves return to the conference tournament for the 10th time in the event's 10-year history.

The Seawolves enter the postseason as the hottest team in the conference, riding an 11-game winning streak and claiming their sixth straight regular-season title with a 19-1 conference mark (29-2 overall) under eighth-year head coach **Ryan McCarthy**. The nationally-ranked and fundamentally-sound Seawolves have one of the most balanced teams in Division II, ranking sixth in the nation with a +21.9 scoring margin and third with 389 steals.

Despite winning 30 games and losing just one conference game last season, the Seawolves were picked to finish third in the 2019-20 GNAC Preseason Women's Basketball Coaches Poll. On a mission to prove the poll wrong, the Seawolves got off to a solid 8-0 start to conference play before finally losing at Western Washington on Jan. 23. The Seawolves haven't lost a game since then, finishing the regular season averaging 75.7 points per game and leading the conference in scoring defense, allowing just 54.1 points per game.

The Seawolves solidified their spot at the top of the conference standings with a trio of upperclassmen leading the way. Senior guard **Yazmeen Goo** is averaging 9.9 points, 2.6 rebounds and 3.9 assists per game and ranks third in the GNAC with a .566 field goal percentage. Fellow senior guard **Safiyah Yasin** leads the Seawolves and ranks seventh in the conference in scoring with 14.1 points per game while also ranking third with 2.1 steals per game. Junior forward/center **Tennae Voliva** is averaging 9.7 points and is fourth in the conference with 7.6 rebounds per game.

Northwest Nazarene, last year's GNAC Championships winner, is the No. 2 seed after finishing the regular season with a 22-6 overall record and a 17-3 conference mark. The Nighthawks return to the tournament for the fifth straight year with one of the most potent defenses in the nation. The Nighthawks rank third in Division II with 14.1 steals per game and sixth with 23.11 turnovers forced per game.

A formidable duo in senior guards **Avery Albrecht** and **Marina Valles** paced the Nighthawks in 2019-20. Albrecht is fourth in the conference with 15 points per game to go with 5.9 rebounds per game and a .492 field goal percentage. Valles is having a phenomenal season as a two-way player, averaging 14.5 points, 4.4 rebounds and 4.4 assists per game and ranking eighth in Division II with 3.11 steals per game.

Western Washington is the only GNAC team to take down the Seawolves in 2019-20 and enters the GNAC Championships as the No. 3 seed with a 14-6 conference record (20-8 overall). The Vikings have won four of their last five games and lead the conference in rebounds, assists, blocked shots and field goal percentage.



The Vikings are led by senior center **Anna Schwecke**, who averages 12.8 points and 6.3 rebounds per game while leading the GNAC with a .610 field goal percentage and a .869 free-throw percentage. Junior guard **Emma Duff** averages 11.6 points per game and is the team's leading rebounder with 6.8 rebounds per game.

Simon Fraser has clinched a berth in the GNAC Championships every year that it has been a member of the conference, returning to the tournament for the 10th time. The Clan claimed the No. 4 seed on a tiebreaker after finishing the regular season at 18-12 overall and 13-7 in conference play.

Junior guard **Jessica Jones** is the Clan's top scorer, ranking second in the GNAC with 17.3 points per game while adding 4.2 rebounds per game. Jones leads the conference and ranks 13th in Division II with 3.16 three-point field goals made

per game. Point guard **Taylor Drynan**, the Clan's only senior, is averaging 9.9 points, 2.3 rebounds and 4.1 assists per game while junior forward **Ozioma Nwabuko** anchors the defensive end while averaging 8.9 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.

Central Washington returns to the tournament as the No. 5 seed after being picked to win it all in the preseason poll. The Wildcats have won seven of their last nine games and enter the tournament riding a four-game win streak, finishing the regular season with a 13-7 conference mark (18-10 overall). The Wildcats lead the GNAC in free throw percentage and three-point field goals made.

The Wildcats have five players who are averaging 10 points per game or better, led by senior guard **Alexis Pana**, who ranks sixth in the GNAC with 14.3 points per game while also leading the conference with 4.9 assists per game. Senior forward **Kaelie Flores** is averaging 12.2 points, 6.5 rebounds and 1.5 blocked shots per game while sophomore center **Samantha Bowman** ranks second in the conference with a .609 field goal percentage.

Despite losing four of its final six games of the regular season, Montana State Billings earned the No. 6 seed on a tiebreaker and returns to the tournament after a one-year absence. The Yellowjackets finished the regular season at 14-15 overall and 9-11 in conference play.

Sophomore forward **Taryn Shelley** is averaging 13.3 points and 8.4 rebounds per game and has registered 11 double-doubles on the season. Senior guard **Jeanann Lemelin** has been lethal from outside, ranking second in the conference with 2.3 three-pointers made per game and a .406 three-point percentage.

The GNAC Championships will start on Thursday with No. 3 Western Washington and No. 6 Montana State Billings going head-to-head at 5:15 p.m. The winner will face No. 2 Northwest Nazarene at 5:15 p.m. on Friday. No. 4 Simon Fraser and No. 5 Central Washington will play at 7:30 p.m. with the winner advancing to play No. 1 Alaska Anchorage at 7:30 p.m. on Friday. The championship game is scheduled to tip off at 7:30 p.m. on Saturday.

Around The GNAC

ALASKA ANCHORAGE



• Alaska Anchorage extended its winning streak to 11 games in Oregon to clinch its sixth straight regular-season title. The Seawolves beat Western Oregon on Thursday, 76-48, and Concordia on Saturday, 60-47.

• **Safiyah Yasin** led the Seawolves with 28 points in the two games to go with 11 rebounds, one assist and one

block while shooting 50 percent from the field and three-point range and 85.7 percent from the free-throw line. Yasin opened the week with 15 points and five rebounds at WOU then followed with 13 points and six rebounds at CU. Yasin ranks seventh in the GNAC in scoring with 14.1 points per game and third with 2.1 steals per game.

• **Rachel Ingram** was key off the bench for the Seawolves, finishing the week with totals of 21 points, four rebounds, two steals, an assist and a block. Ingram connected on 7 of 16 from the field on the week, all coming from beyond the arc. She scored 12 points against the Wolves then contributed nine points against the Cavaliers.

• The Seawolves rank fourth in Division II with 399 steals, sixth with a +21.6 scoring margin, ninth with a +8.89 turnover margin and 10th with 502 assists.

• The Seawolves are ranked No. 5 in the latest WBCA Division II Rankings and No. 6 in the latest D2SIDA poll. The Seawolves were ranked No. 2 in the NCAA Division II West Region Rankings, released last Wednesday.

• After running away with the regular-season title with a 19-1 conference mark (29-2 overall), Alaska Anchorage enters the GNAC Championships as the No. 1 seed. The Seawolves will play the winner of No. 4 Simon Fraser and No. 5 Central Washington at 7:30 p.m. on Friday.

CENTRAL WASHINGTON



• Central Washington extended its winning streak to four games with a 70-60 win at Saint Martin's on Thursday and an 81-65 win at Seattle Pacific on Saturday.

• **Kaelie Flores** led the Wildcats with 36 points to go with 11 rebounds, two assists and two blocks. Flores opened the week with 20 points and eight rebounds while shooting 7 of 12 from the field, 4 of 8 from three-point range and 2 of 2 from the free-throw line at SMU. She closed the week with 16 points on 6 of 9 from the field and 3 of 5 from outside at SPU. Flores is averaging 12.2 points and 6.5 rebounds per game and ranks fifth in the GNAC with a .396 three-point field goal percentage.

• **Alexis Pana** finished the week with totals of 31 points, 18 rebounds, 10 assists, four steals and a block. Pana registered a double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds to go with five assists and four steals against the Saints. She finished the week with 20 points, eight rebounds and five assists while connecting on 9 of 16 from the field and 2 of 5 from beyond the arc against the Falcons. Pana leads the conference and ranks 24th in Division II with 4.9 assists per game.

• The preseason favorite, Central Washington enters the GNAC Championships as the No. 5 seed, finishing the regular season with a 13-7 conference record (18-10 overall). The Wildcats will play No. 4 Simon Fraser at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday.

MONTANA STATE BILLINGS



- Montana State Billings went 0-2 at home last week, losing to Western Washington on Thursday, 76-72, and to Simon Fraser on Saturday, 72-66.

- **Taryn Shelley** scored 29 points and added nine rebounds, four blocks and two steals in the two games. She scored 14 points on 7 of 11 from the field to go with three rebounds and two blocks against the Vikings. She finished the week with a

15-point, six-rebound performance against the Clan. Shelley is averaging 13.3 points and 8.4 rebounds per game and has registered 11 double-doubles on the season.

- **Shayla Montague** finished the week with 23 points, 17 rebounds, two assists, two steals and a block as she connected on 66.7 percent from the field. She scored nine points on a perfect 3 of 3 from the field and 2 of 2 from the free-throw line while also pulling down eight rebounds against the Vikings. - Despite losing four of their last six games of the regular season, the Yellowjackets sneaked into the GNAC Championships as the No. 6 seed, edging out Saint Martin's on a tiebreaker. The Yellowjackets finished the regular season at 14-15 overall and 9-11 in conference play.

- The Yellowjackets will play No. 3 Western Washington at 5:15 p.m. on Thursday to open the women's tournament.

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene went 2-0 in Washington last week, beating Seattle Pacific on Thursday, 77-55, and Saint Martin's on Saturday, 71-52.

- **Marina Valles** led the Nighthawks to the pair of wins with 34 points, three rebounds, five assists and 10 steals while shooting 60.9 percent from the field and 75 percent from the free-throw line. Valles scored 16 points and added three assists, two rebounds and two steals at SPU and then added 18 points, eight steals and two assists while connecting on 8 of 14 from the field at SMU. Valles leads the GNAC and ranks seventh in Division II with 92 steals and 3.29 steals per game.

- **Avery Albrecht** finished the week with totals of 29 points, 10 rebounds and two steals as she made 52.2 percent from the field. Her week was highlighted by a 23-point, eight-rebound performance against the Falcons. Albrecht is fourth in the conference in scoring with 15 points per game while also ranking eighth with a .492 field goal percentage.

- The Nighthawks were ranked No. 5 in the latest NCAA West Region Rankings, released last Wednesday.

- Riding a seven-game win streak, the Northwest Nazarene enters the GNAC Championships as the No. 2 seed after finishing the regular season with a 17-3 conference mark (22-6 overall). The Nighthawks will play the winner of No. 3 Western Washington and No. 6 Montana State Billings at 5:15 p.m. on Friday.

SIMON FRASER



- Simon Fraser split on the road last week, losing at Western Washington on Tuesday, 95-66, before bouncing back to win at Montana State Billings on Saturday, 72-66.

- **Claudia Hart** scored in double digits in both games, connecting on 46.4 percent from the field, 41.7 percent from three-point range and 80 percent from the free-throw line.

Hart opened with 11 points on 4 of 10 from the field and 3 of 5 from beyond the arc at WWU. She then went off for 28 points on 9 of 18 from the field and 8 of 10 from the free-throw line while adding eight rebounds at MSUB. Hart is averaging 8.7 points and 4.6 rebounds per game and has a .430 field goal percentage.

- **Jessica Wisotzki** scored 18 points and added four rebounds, three steals, an assist and a block while connecting on 42.9 percent from the field in the two games. Wisotzki came off the bench against WWU and scored 10 points to go with two rebounds. She then started at MSUB and contributed eight points, two rebounds and two steals.

- The Clan was ranked No. 9 in the latest NCAA West Region Rankings, released last Wednesday.

- **Emma Duff** earned the last GNAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week award of the season after she led the Vikings with 39 points and 24 rebounds to go with seven assists and four steals. She notched a double-double of 18 points and 15 rebounds in Tuesday's win over Simon Fraser and then finished just short of another double-double with 21 points and nine rebounds in Billings. Duff connected on 64 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from three-point range on the week. She is averaging 11.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game.

- **Anna Schwecke** scored in double digits in both games as she made 56.3 percent from the field and 100 percent from the free-throw line. Schwecke scored 10 points and added six rebounds and a pair of steals against SFU. She finished the week with 12 points and five rebounds at MSUB. Schwecke is averaging 12.8 points and 6.3 rebounds per game and leads the GNAC with a .610 field goal percentage and a .869 free throw percentage.
