## OFFENSIVE

**Kayleigh Harper, Western Washington**

Harper finished the regular season with 32 kills, 12 blocks and a .460 hitting percentage as she led the Vikings to two more wins and the team's third consecutive GNAC championship. She opened the week with 16 kills, seven blocks, two digs, a service ace and a .471 hitting percentage in a three-set sweep at Central Washington on Thursday. Harper then closed out the regular season with 16 kills, five blocks, four digs, two service aces and a .448 hitting percentage at Northwest Nazarene on Saturday. Harper finished the regular season leading the GNAC with a .386 hitting percentage and 1.45 blocks per set.

She finished with 16 digs in Tuesday's three-set win at Western Oregon to go along with two aces. She then posted a career-high of 34 digs to go along with six assists to help the Cavs to a four-set win over Montana State Billings at home on Saturday.

# NCAA West Regional Preview

SAN BERNARDINO, Calif. - For the three teams that will represent the GNAC at the NCAA West Regional Volleyball Championships, the postseason setting is anything but new.

Both Western Washington and Central Washington are in the field for the eighth consecutive year. Alaska Anchorage is returning for the first time since 2017, but was part of the field each of the previous five seasons.

All three teams have the ability to advance far in the tournament, which begins Thursday at The Den on the campus of Cal State San Bernardino.

Western Washington, the tournament's No. 2 seed, would love to capture a second straight trip to the NCAA Division II Championships next week in Denver. The Vikings won last year's West Regional, which the team hosted in Bellingham, and advanced to the national championship match before taking a five-set loss to Tampa.

Entering the regional with a 26-2 overall record and a No. 4 national ranking, WWU opened the season by winning 17 straight matches before taking a four-set loss at Alaska Anchorage on Oct. 19. In fact, both of Western Washington's losses have come at the hands of the Seawolves, the No. 4 seed in the regional field. The two teams would only meet in the regional final.

The Vikings lead Division II with 2.95 blocks per set and are ranked sixth with a .273 hitting percentage. Western Washington leads the GNAC in hitting percentage, blocks per set, opponent hitting percentage (.126), kills per set (13.97) and assists per set (13.21).

The Vikings are led by senior middle blocker **Kayleigh Harper**, who was named the GNAC Player of the Year and earned First Team All-West Region honors from both the AVCA and D2CCA. Just the third player in conference history to be named First Team All-GNAC four times, finished the season leading the GNAC and ranked 16th in Division II with a .386 hitting percentage while also ranking second nationally with 1.45 blocks per set. She also ranks third in the GNAC with 4.15 points per set and eighth with 3.23 kills per set.

Harper finished with double-digit kills in 16 of her 28 matches and finished with 10 blocks on two occasions. She is the all-time GNAC leader with 583 and counting.

Outside hitter **Calley Heilborn** was the GNAC Freshman of the Year and also earned First Team All-West Region honors from the AVCA. She was joined on the AVCA First Team by sophomore outside hitter Gabby Gunterman while freshman setter **Malia Aleaga** was named to the D2CCA First Team.

Alaska Anchorage enters the regional tournament with a 22-6 record and was second in the GNAC behind Western Washington at 17-3. The Seawolves did not advance past the opening round of the 2017 West Regional, but won the 2016 regional at their own Alaska Airlines Center and advanced to the national final.

Alaska Anchorage has a 3-3 record against the regionals field. In addition to the wins over Western Washington, the Seawolves split the season series with Central Washington, winning in three sets in Anchorage on Oct. 3 and losing in five sets in Ellensburg on Oct. 26.

Sophomore right-side hitter **Eve Stephens** joined Harper as being named to both the AVCA and D2CCA All-West Region first teams in addition to First Team All-GNAC accolades. Stephens leads the GNAC and is 14th in Division II with 4.70 points per set while also leading the conference and ranking 30th in Division II with 3.97 per set. Stephens

finished with double-digit kills in 22 matches and registered double-doubles in 11 of those matches.

Sophomore setter **Ellen Floyd** earned First Team All-West Region honors from the AVCA in addition to her First Team All-GNAC plaque. Floyd finished the regular season second in the GNAC with 10.23 assists per set while also averaging 2.72 digs and 0.72 blocks per set. She posted double-doubles (assists and digs) in 17 matches and had a season-high of 52 assists twice, most recently against Montana State Billings on Sept. 28. Floyd was named the AVCA Division II National Player of the Week on Nov. 19.

Led by GNAC Coach of the Year **Chris Green**, Alaska Anchorage is averaging 12.42 kills and 15.41 digs per set with a .236 hitting percentage, which ranks second in the GNAC and 31st in Division II. The Seawolves lead the GNAC and rank eighth in Division II with 2.17 aces per set and are second in the GNAC and sixth in Division II with 2.56 blocks per set.

Lower seeds are familiar territory for Central Washington in the West Regional, but certainly not an insurmountable challenge. A No. 5 seed or lower in five of their last seven tournaments, the Wildcats broke through last year with a five-set win over No. 3 seed Cal State LA before falling in the semifinals in four sets to this year's first-round opponent, Cal State San Bernardino.

Entering the tournament with an 18-10 overall record, Central Washington is 2-4 against the regional field this season with one win over Alaska Anchorage and one win over Cal State LA in the D2 West Region Showcase. Central Washington enters the West Regional ranked third in the GNAC with 12.93 kills per set. The Wildcats are second in the GNAC and 32nd in Division II with 18.23 digs per set. The team is also second in the GNAC with a .155 opponent hitting percentage.

The Wildcats are led by senior libero **Kyla Morgan**, who repeated as the GNAC Defensive Player of the Year. She earned Second Team All-West Region honors from the D2CCA and was an honorable mention on the AVCA team. Morgan leads the conference and ranks 13th in Division II with 5.87 digs per set. She registered double-digits in digs in all but two of the Wildcats' 28 matches and surpassed 30 kills in five matches.

Junior outside hitter **Makala Swart** was named both First Team All-GNAC and Honorable Mention AVCA All-West Region. She finished seventh in the GNAC with 3.30 kills per set and eighth with 3.74 points per set. She finished with double-digit kills in 21 matches in the regular season.

Tournament host and No. 1 seed Cal State San Bernardino, the CCAA regular-season and tournament champion, enters with an unblemished 27-0 record and a No. 1 ranking in the AVCA Coaches Top-25 Poll. No. 3 seed Cal State LA is 22-6 on the season and is ranked No. 24. The Golden Eagles lost in five sets to Cal State San Bernardino in the CCAA Tournament finals.

UC San Diego is the No. 5 seed. In their last season as a Division II member, the Tritons are 18-8 on the season and were upset by Sonoma State in five sets in the first round of the CCAA Championships. Azusa Pacific, the No. 6 seed, was the PacWest Conference champion. The Cougars are No. 25 in the AVCA poll and enter with a 26-4 overall record and a 10-match win streak.

The No. 7 seed, Hawaii Hilo finished second in the PacWest and enters the regional with a 23-7 overall record.

# GNAC Teams In The NCAA West Regional

## ALASKA ANCHORAGE



• Alaska Anchorage is in the NCAA Division II Championship for the first time since 2017 and for the ninth time in the program's GNAC history.

• The Seawolves did not advance past the regional quarterfinals in 2017 as the No. 7 seed, losing in four sets to No. 2 seed Western Washington. The year before, Alaska

Anchorage advanced to the national championship where they took a three-set loss to Concordia-St. Paul.

• Alaska Anchorage is 3-3 against teams in the NCAA West Regional. Both wins came over Western Washington, knocking off the Vikings in four sets in Anchorage on Oct. 19 and scoring a five-set win in Bellingham on Nov. 14. They split the season series with Central Washington, winning in three sets in Anchorage on Oct. 3 and losing in five sets in Ellensburg on Oct. 26. The Seawolves lost in four sets to UC San Diego on Sept. 7 and in three sets to Cal State San Bernardino on Sept. 13.

• Sophomore right-side hitter **Eve Stephens** earned First Team All-GNAC honors and was one of two GNAC players to be named First Team All-West Region by both the AVCA and D2CCA. Stephens leads the GNAC and is 14th in Division II with 4.70 points per set while also leading the conference and ranking 30th in Division II with 3.97 per set. Stephens finished with double-digit kills in 22 matches and registered double-doubles in 11 of those matches. She posted a season-high of 23 kills twice, most recently at Central Washington on Nov. 2.

• Sophomore setter **Ellen Floyd** also earned First Team All-GNAC honors and was named First Team All-West Region by the AVCA. Floyd finished the regular season second in the GNAC with 10.23 assists per set while also averaging 2.72 digs and 0.72 blocks per set. She posted double-doubles (assists and digs) in 17 matches and had a season-high of 52 assists twice, most recently against Montana State Billings on Sept. 28. Floyd was named the AVCA Division II National Player of the Week on Nov. 19 after she had 91 assists, 29 digs, nine blocks and seven kills in wins over Western Washington and Simon Fraser.

• Also earning First Team All-GNAC honors for Alaska Anchorage was senior outside hitter **Vanessa Hayes**, who is tied for second in the GNAC and 24th in Division II with 0.48 aces per set. In addition, head coach **Chris Green** was named the GNAC Coach of the Year for the fifth time in his career.

• Alaska Anchorage is listed fourth among teams receiving votes in the AVCA Division II Coaches Poll, receiving 41 points.

• Alaska Anchorage enters the West Regional averaging 12.42 kills and 15.41 digs per set with a .236 hitting percentage, which ranks second in the GNAC and 31st in Division II. The Seawolves lead the GNAC and rank eighth in Division II with 2.17 aces per set and are second in the GNAC and sixth in Division II with 2.56 blocks per set.

## CENTRAL WASHINGTON



• Central Washington is in the NCAA Championships for the eighth consecutive year and the 12th time in program history.

• After going seven years without a regional victory, the Wildcats finally broke through in 2018 as the No. 6 seed downed No. 3 seed Cal State LA in five sets. Central was bumped in the semifinals in a four-set loss to No. 2 seed Cal

State San Bernardino.

• Central Washington is 2-4 against teams in the West Regional this season. The Wildcats beat Cal State LA in five sets on Sept. 12 and lost in five sets to Azusa Pacific on Sept. 13, both at the D2 West Region Volleyball Showcase. Central split its season series with Alaska Anchorage, losing in three sets in Anchorage on Oct. 3 and winning in five sets in Ellensburg on Nov. 2. The Wildcats lost both meetings to Western Washington in three sets.

• For the second year in a row, senior libero **Kyla Morgan** was named the GNAC Defensive Player of the Year. She also earned First Team All-GNAC, Second Team D2CCA All-West Region and Honorable Mention AVCA All-West Region honors. Morgan leads the conference and ranks 13th in Division II with 5.87 digs per set. She registered double-digits in digs in all but two of the Wildcats' 28 matches and surpassed 30 kills in five matches.

• Junior outside hitter **Makala Swart** was named both First Team All-GNAC and Honorable Mention AVCA All-West Region. She finished seventh in the GNAC with 3.30 kills per set and eighth with 3.74 points per set. She finished with double-digit kills in 21 matches in the regular season, topped by 20 against Seattle Pacific on Oct. 26.

• Central Washington is not ranked in the AVCA Coaches Top-25 Rankings. The Wildcats last received votes on Nov. 11, picking up two votes. The team opened the season ranked No. 23 and was either ranked or received votes in eight poll weeks this year.

• Central Washington enters the West Regional ranked third in the GNAC with 12.93 kills per set. The Wildcats are second in the GNAC and 32nd in Division II with 18.23 digs per set. The team is also second in the GNAC with a .155 opponent hitting percentage.



# GNAC Teams In The NCAA West Regional

## WESTERN WASHINGTON



- Western Washington is in the NCAA Championships for the eighth consecutive year and for the 14th time in the program's GNAC history.
- Hosts and winners of last year's West Regional, the Vikings advanced to the national championship in 2018 where they lost a hard-fought five-set match to Tampa. Western also reached the national finals in 2007 and the semifinals in 2015. In addition, the Vikings have advanced to the West Regional championship match each of the last four years, going 2-2 in those matches.
- Entering the regional with a 26-2 overall record, Western Washington is 3-2 against teams in the West Regional. The Vikings beat Hawaii Hilo in five sets in the D2 West Region Showcase on Sept. 14. They beat Central Washington in three sets in both regular-season meetings and lost both meetings to Alaska Anchorage, in four sets on Oct. 19 and in five sets on Nov. 14.
- Senior middle blocker **Kayleigh Harper** was named the GNAC Player of the Year and became just the third player in conference history to be named First Team All-GNAC four times. She was also named to her fourth AVCA All-West Region First Team and her second AVCA All-West Region First Team. Harper finished the season leading the GNAC and ranked 16th in Division II with a .386 hitting percentage while also ranking second nationally with 1.45 blocks per set. She also ranks third in the GNAC with 4.15 points per set and eighth with 3.23 kills per set. Harper finished with double-digit kills in 16 of her 28 matches and finished with 10 blocks on two occasions. She is the all-time GNAC leader with 583 and counting.
- Freshman outside hitter **Calley Heilborn** was named the GNAC Freshman of the Year, earned First Team All-West Region honors from the AVCA and Second Team All-West Region honors from the D2CCA. She finished the regular season ranked sixth in the GNAC with both 3.31 kills and 3.91 points per set. She finished with double-digit kills in 19 matches, including in her first 14 matches, and had double-doubles in 17 matches. Heilborn posted a season-high of 20 kills twice, most recently against Hawaii Hilo on Sept. 14.
- Freshman setter **Malia Aleaga** earned First Team D2CCA All-West Region and Honorable Mention All-GNAC honors. Aleaga leads the conference and ranks sixth in Division II with 11.74 assists per set. She finished with 30 or more assists in all but two of the Vikings' 28 matches and posted double-doubles (assists & digs) five times. She had a high of 63 assists against Hawaii Hilo on Sept. 14. In addition, Aleaga is averaging 0.64 blocks per set.
- Sophomore outside hitter **Gabby Gunterman** was a First Team All-GNAC and First Team AVCA All-West Region selection. Gunterman closed the regular season ranked 10th in the GNAC with 3.10 kills and 3.82 digs per set with a .255 hitting percentage. She finished with double-digit kills in 15 matches and notched double-doubles in 13 of those matches. She twice posted a season-high of 17 kills, most recently against Hawaii Hilo in September, and had 29 digs against Simon Fraser on Oct. 1.
- Western Washington climbed back up two spots to No. 4 in the latest AVCA Division II Coaches Rankings. The Vikings have been ranked no worse than sixth all season. The most recent poll marks the 107th consecutive poll in which WWU has been in the top-25. The team has been ranked in the top-10 in each of the last three polls.
- The Vikings lead Division II with 2.95 blocks per set and are ranked sixth with a .273 hitting percentage. Western Washington leads the GNAC in hitting percentage, blocks per set, opponent hitting percentage (.126), kills per set (13.97) and assists per set (13.21). The Vikings rank 10th in Division II in assists per set and 19th in kills per set.
