CREWS OF THE WEEK BY YEAR 2019-20

Week of Mar. 2-8: Seattle Pacific Varsity 4+: The first-ever GNAC Crew of the Week, the Seattle Pacific varsity 4+ cruised to a win in its race at the PLU Invitational on Saturday. The Falcon's time of 7:39.52 was 33 seconds better than second-place Western Washington and was the fastest time of all the fours participating in the regatta. The crew consisted of LeeAnn Arrington (coxswain), Amanda Larsen, Suzanne Stafford, Tamyra Clark-Hoogstrate and Danielle Johnson.

Week of Mar. 22-28: Central Oklahoma Varsity 8+: The Bronchos won both of their races at the Falcon Regatta, the team's first competition of the 2020-21 season. The crew won the first varsity 8 flight in a time of 6:53.6, finishing less than a second ahead of Seattle Pacific. They came back for the win in the second flight in a time of 6:51.0, once again just ahead of Seattle Pacific. Week of Feb. 28-Mar. 6: Western Washington Varsity 8+: Rowing in the first competition of the spring season, the Vikings' varsity 8+ won its race at the PLU Invitational on Saturday in a time of 7:01.4. The boat scored a 16-second victory over Seattle Pacific and a 20-second victory over Pacific Lutheran. The time was the third-fastest by a varsity 8+ boat in the regatta, bettered only by two Gonzaga crews. The crew was comprised of coxswain Adele Houston and rowers Lindsey Froelich, Morgan MacIntyre, Clarice Ruhlin-Hicks, Olivia Pella, Emma Clark, Maddie Bangasser, Yuki Saburi and Haley Moss.

Week of Mar. 7-13: Cal Poly Humboldt Varsity 8+: The Lumberjacks won the varsity 8+ race at Sunday's Aggie Invitational in Sacramento, finishing in a time of 7:13.3 to cross the line seven seconds ahead of UC Davis. On Saturday, Cal Poly Humboldt opened the season with a third-place finish at the Sacramento State Invitational. They were in the middle of a cadre of Division I teams with a time of 7:20.4. The crew was comprised of coxswain Sophie Reich, Malia Seeley, Kealey Scott, Cassidy Hollenbeck, Dana Foley, Emily Marsolais, Kierstyn Hughes and Chloe Pieper-Wasem. Week of Mar. 21-27: Central Oklahoma Varsity 8+: The Bronchos won in head-to-head competition with Seattle Pacific in Saturday's regatta on the Oklahoma River with a winning time of 6:56.05. Earlier in the day, Central Oklahoma placed a close third to a pair of Kansas boats in a time of 6:54.34. Week of Mar. 28-Apr. 3: Western Washington Varsity 4+: Competing in its first regatta in a month, Western Washington won the collegiate varsity 4+ race at the Husky Open in Seattle in a time of 8:01.049. The Vikings were over eight seconds ahead of Division I Portland in earning the victory. Week of Apr. 4-10: Western Washington Varsity 4+: The Vikings' Varsity 4+ was a dominant winner over GNAC foes Seattle Pacific and Cal Poly Humboldt at the Falcon Regatta on Saturday. In the first flight of races, the Vikings won in a time of 7:50.9, posting a 14-second victory over Seattle Pacific and a 25-second victory over Cal Poly Humboldt. Week of Apr. 11-17: Cal Poly Humboldt Varsity 4+: The Lumberjacks won both of their races at the Covered Bridge Regatta in Eugene, Oregon. Western Washington finished four seconds ahead of second-place Cal Poly Humboldt and nine seconds ahead of third-place Seattle Pacific. On Saturday, WWU had the top time in the preliminary heats with a time of 6:57.535. Week of Feb. 27-Mar. 5: Seattle Pacific Varsity 8+: The Seattle Pacific varsity 8+ opened the season by picking up two of the Falcons' six victories at the PLU Invitational. In the first session of races, SPU was a six-second winner over Western Washington, winning in a time of 7:06.73. In the second session, the Falcons put 22 seconds of space between their boat and second-place Puget Sound, winning in 7:02.81. Week of Mar. 20-26: Cal Poly Humboldt Varsity 4+: The Lumberjacks won both college women's varsity 4+ races at the Husky Open in Seattle. In the first race, Humboldt won in a time of 8:12.502, finishing six seconds ahead of second-place Seattle Pacific. The Lumberjacks made it an eight-second win in the second race of the day, winning in a time of 8:23.635.
