Arceneaux helped Western Oregon clinch a GNAC Championships berth by hitting .667 in the final two days of the regular season, going 8 for 12 with two runs, two doubles and four RBIs. After finishing with a hit in each of Saturday's games against Simon Fraser, Arceneaux went 3 for 5 with a run and three RBIs in Sunday's opening 11-10 win over Western Washington, which included the game-winning hit in the eighth inning that secured WOU's postseason berth. She then went 3 for 3 in the nightcap, which included an RBI double in the first.

## PITCHER

**Alia Stachoski, Simon Fraser**

Stachoski had three complete-game wins to help lead Simon Fraser to its first GNAC Championships berth in five years. In 20 innings, Stachoski allowed three runs on 13 hits and struck out 11. She went the distance to earn the 4-0 win over Western Oregon on Saturday, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out six. Stachoski posted the victory in Sunday's 4-3, eight-inning win in the opener with Concordia, allowing three runs on eight hits with three strikeouts. She closed out the twinbill by allowing three hits and one walk while striking out two in the 11-0, five-inning second game.

# GNAC Softball Championships Preview

PORTLAND, Ore. – It was a run right until the final innings of the regular season to set the field for the 2018 GNAC Softball Championships.

Only one team had secured a playoff berth entering the final week, leaving three teams to rally to make the four-team field for the tournament, which begins Thursday at Concordia University's Porter Park.

Northwest Nazarene locked up its tournament berth two weeks ago. Central Washington, Simon Fraser and Western Oregon had to wait until the final weekend of the season to determine their fate, with the Clan and Wolves waiting until the final day. The tournament opens on Thursday with the winner receiving the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Division II Championship.

Northwest Nazarene, in the GNAC Championships for the first time, used solid hitting and excellent pitching to collect a share of its first regular-season championship. Winners of five of seven GNAC series during the regular season and eight of their last 10 games, the Nighthawks (28-21, 19-9 GNAC) lead the conference with a .316 batting average and rank second with a 3.57 earned run average.

Freshman **Jordan Adams** has been hard to stop in the circle. Ranked 30th in Division II with a league-leading 1.49 earned run average, Adams is 17-6 on the season and has held opponents to a .196 batting average. She also leads the GNAC with 138 strikeouts and is 29th in Division II with 4.98 hits allowed per seven innings.

Northwest Nazarene's offense features seven batters hitting .300 or better and three of the GNAC's top-10 hitters. Sophomore **Brittany Genaurdi** paces the lineup with a .371 batting average and leads the GNAC with 32 walks. Junior **Kylie Orr** is batting .367 and leads the GNAC with 44 RBIs and junior Cassidy Fifield is hitting .355 with 55 hits.

Central Washington, the tournament's No. 2 seed, rallied over the two weeks to win five straight games and earn a share of its third straight regular-season title and its third straight GNAC Championships berth. The Wildcats (31-14, 19-9 GNAC) lead the conference with a 2.97 earned run average and have allowed the fewest walks (70) of any GNAC team. Offensively, the Wildcats are second in the GNAC with a .313 batting average and lead the conference with 80 stolen bases.

Sophomore **Savannah Egbert** has provided much of the offensive muscle for the Wildcats. Second in the GNAC with a .458 batting average, Egbert enters the tournament with a .503 on-base percentage and is 26th in Division II with 0.68 stolen bases per game (29 total). Freshman **Katie Kastning** is batting .379 while junior **Rachael Johnson** is batting .368 with 18 stolen bases.



The Wildcats also have a flame-throwing freshman of their own in **Lexie Strasser**. Second to Adams in the GNAC with a 2.60 earned run average, Strasser leads the league with 18 wins and has given up just 28 walks in 158 innings.

Simon Fraser is in the GNAC Championships for the first time in five years. Picked to finish eighth out of eight teams this season, the Clan (19-17, 15-13 GNAC) rallied to win five of their last seven games of the season, and three of four on the final weekend, to pull into a third-place tie with Western Oregon in the regular season standings. The trip to the postseason is a nice retirement gift for head coach **Mike Renney**, who will step down after 24 seasons at the end of the season.

The Clan enters the tournament with a .264 batting average. Senior **Taylor Lundrigan** leads the team with a .351 batting average, 25 RBIs and a .518 slugging percentage. Freshman **Kate Fergusson** is batting .336 in her first collegiate season.

Senior **Alia Stachoski** leads the Simon Fraser pitching staff with a 3.43 earned run average and is ninth in Division II with five saves. Stachoski closed the regular season by winning all three games for the Clan on the final weekend in complete-game efforts. The Clan is the top fielding team in the conference, ranking 23rd in Division II with a .970 fielding percentage.

Western Oregon, in the GNAC Championships for the sixth year, is making a habit of waiting until the final day to qualify for the tournament. The Wolves (27-23, 15-13 GNAC) used an 11-10, eight-inning win over Western Washington on Sunday to lock up the No. 4 seed. Western Oregon is third in the GNAC with a .309 batting average while their 0.15 triples per game (18 total) is 17th in Division II.

Senior **Ryanne Huffman** is making the most of her final season, leading WOU offensively and ranking fourth in the GNAC with a .409 batting average. Her five triples on the season rank 30th in Division II. Freshman **Tyler Creach** is right behind Huffman with a .404 batting average to go along with 16 stolen bases. Both players have 67 hits on the season, tying for third in the GNAC, while Creach's 41 runs scored is second.

Senior **Lizzet Dominguez** has been the Wolves best pitcher over the second half of the season, entering the Championships with 12 wins and a 3.43 earned run average. Senior **Haley Fabian** has won 10 games and owns a 4.17 earned run average.

Action at the GNAC Championships begins on Thursday with No. 3 Simon Fraser facing No. 2 Central Washington at 4:30 p.m. No. 4 Western Oregon and No. 1 Northwest Nazarene will square off at 7 p.m. The championship game in the double-elimination tournament takes place Saturday at noon.

# GNAC Championships Participating Teams

## CENTRAL WASHINGTON



- Central Washington secured its third straight GNAC Championships berth and a share of the regular-season championship with a sweep of Saint Martin's over the weekend. The Wildcats won both games in Ellensburg on Saturday, 11-6 and 10-7, and swept Sunday in Lacey, 5-4 and 5-3.
- Junior **Rachael Johnson** was the offensive force for the Wildcats last week, batting .538 in the four games as she went 7 for 13 with five runs and an RBI. She went 2 for 3 and scored two runs in Saturday's opener and then went 2 for 3 in Sunday's opener. Johnson enters the GNAC Championships with a .368 batting average.
- Sophomore **Savannah Egbert** leads CWU and is second in the GNAC and 22nd in Division II with a .458 batting average. She is second in the league and 20th in Division with 70 hits. In all, Central Washington has six players with batting averages north of .300, including freshman **Sydney Brown** at .394 and freshman **Katie Kastning** at .379.
- Freshman **Lexie Strasser** earned two of the four pitching wins last weekend for CWU, allowing 13 runs, 11 earned, on 26 hits while appearing in all four games. She went the distance to earn wins in Saturday's opener, which CWU won 11-6, and Sunday's opener, 5-4. Strasser is second in the GNAC with a 2.60 earned run average and leads the GNAC with 18 wins.
- Central Washington is the only GNAC team in the latest NCAA Division II West Region rankings. They were No. 9 in last week's rankings with the new poll coming out on Wednesday.
- Central Washington leads the GNAC with a 2.97 earned run average and is second in the league with a .313 batting average.

## NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene secured a share of its first GNAC regular-season championship and the No. 1 seed in its first appearance in the GNAC Championships with a split at Montana State Billings. The Nighthawks won the opener on Friday, 6-0, and lost the nightcap 6-5. They also won Saturday's opener, 6-5, and fell in the final game 6-4.
- Junior **Kylie Orr** led the NNU offensive effort as she batted .571 in the four games, going 8 for 14 with four runs, five RBIs and three doubles. She went 3 for 4 in Friday's opener with a run scored and then went 2 for 4 in the night with five RBIs and a grand slam in the third inning. Orr opened Saturday by going 3 for 3 in the opener. Orr enters the week eighth in the GNAC with a .367 batting average and leads the GNAC with 44 RBIs.
- Freshman **Jordan Adams** went 1-1 in the circle for the Nighthawks. She threw a one-hitter in Friday's opener, striking out 15 in the process. She enters the week leading the GNAC and ranked 30th in Division II with a 1.49 earned run average. She is also 29th in Division II with 4.98 hits allowed per seven innings.
- Northwest Nazarene enters the tournament with seven batters hitting .300 or better. Sophomore **Brittany Genuardi** leads the group as she is seventh in the GNAC with a .371 average. She is second in the GNAC with 40 RBIs and leads the league with 32 walks. Junior **Cassidy Fifield** is 10th in the GNAC with her .355 average.
- Northwest Nazarene leads the GNAC with a .316 batting average and is second with a 3.57 earned run average. The Nighthawks are 12th in Division II in fielding double plays, averaging 0.47 per game.

## SIMON FRASER



- Simon Fraser won four of its last five games to earn its first GNAC Championships berth in five years. The Clan split Saturday's twinbill at Western Oregon, losing the opener 8-0 (6 inn.) and winning the nightcap 4-0. They finished the regular season with a sweep at Concordia on Sunday, 4-3 (8 inn.) and 11-0 (5 inn.).
- Senior **Alia Stachoski** was named the GNAC Pitcher of the Week after she won all three games for the Clan over the weekend, all in complete-game efforts. In 20 innings, Stachoski allowed three runs on 13 hits and struck out 11. She went the distance to earn the 4-0 win over Western Oregon on Saturday, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out six. Stachoski posted the victory in Sunday's 4-3, eight-inning win in the opener with Concordia, allowing three runs on eight hits with three strikeouts. She closed out the twinbill by allowing three hits and one walk while striking out two in the 11-0, five-inning second game. Stachoski enters the tournament with a 3.43 earned run average and is ninth in Division II with five saves.
- Freshman **Kate Fergusson** led the Clan offensively with a .583 average in the four games, going 7 for 12 with three runs and five RBIs. She went 3 for 4 in Saturday's nightcap at WOU, which included a pair of RBI singles. At CU, Fergusson went 2 for 4 in the opener and 2 for 3 in the nightcap, including an RBI single and double. Fergusson enters the tournament with a .336 batting average.
- Senior **Taylor Lundrigan** leads the SFU offense with a .351 batting average. As a team, the Clan is batting .264 and owns a 4.43 earned run average.
- One of the top defensive teams in Division II, Simon Fraser is 23rd in Division II with a .970 fielding percentage. The Clan has made just 31 errors in 36 games.

## WESTERN OREGON



- After splitting with Simon Fraser on Saturday, Western Oregon secured its GNAC Championships berth with a sweep of Western Washington. The Wolves won the opener 11-10 in eight innings and took the nightcap 11-2 in six innings.
- Redshirt freshman **Ayanna Arceneaux** was named the GNAC Softball of the Week after she hit .667 in the four games, going 8 for 12 with two runs, four RBIs and two doubles. After finishing with a hit in each of Saturday's games against Simon Fraser, Arceneaux went 3 for 5 with a run and three RBIs in Sunday's opening 11-10 win over Western Washington, which included the game-winning hit in the eighth inning that secured WOU's postseason berth. She then went 3 for 3 in the nightcap, which included an RBI double in the first. Arceneaux enters the tournament with a .348 batting average.
- Senior **Haley Fabian** put together a solid weekend as she posted two wins and a 1.17 earned run average in the games. She threw a one-hitter in Saturday's 8-0 win over Simon Fraser, facing two batters over the minimum. She was also the winner in Sunday's nightcap with WWU, allowing two runs on six hits. Fabian enters the GNAC Championships with 10 wins and a 4.17 earned run average.
- Senior **Ryanne Huffman** leads the WOU offense. She is fourth in the GNAC with a .409 batting average. Freshman **Tyler Creach** is not far behind with a .404 average. Both Huffman and Creach had 67 hits on the season, third in the GNAC. Huffman also has five triples on the season, ranking her 30th in Division II.
- Western Oregon enters the tournament with a .309 batting average and a 4.02 earned run average. The Wolves are fourth in Division II in double plays per game, turning 0.54 per contest.
